

Ongoing work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road from 8 January to 31 May 2024

Transport for NSW is delivering the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. Work has progressed on property adjustments, utility work and on widening of the road under the M4 Motorway.

What work will we do in the coming months?

Work to be done next includes:

- Progressing property adjustments
- Continuing widening Mulgoa Road under the M4 Motorway
- Utility work including relocating the utilities and boring under the road to install utilities safely
- Restoring the worksite when work is finished.

When and where will we be working?

To progress construction, work will continue over the period of 8 January to 31 May 2024 on Mulgoa Road and surrounding streets between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road (see map overleaf).

Due to high traffic volumes on Mulgoa Road, to maintain access for businesses and residents and for the safety of our workers and road users, some of this work needs to be done at night.

Working days and hours are:

Day times

- Between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday
- Between 8am and 1pm on Saturday

Night-time

- We will advise you of night work dates closer to the time.

Noisy work

We will be using machinery such as core drills, excavators, jackhammers, vibratory rollers, bobcats, vacuum trucks, saw cutting equipment and other trucks for transporting material.

There may be some vibration impact from this work.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used, during day and night work.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

Major traffic changes

To enable work to progress we need to make some temporary changes to traffic as advised in our notification in August 2023.

- **Left out of Jeanette Street closed** – from **15 January 2024**, with a **temporary roundabout installed at the corner of Jeanette Street and School House Road**. This change will allow utilities to be relocated under Jeanette Street and increase safety for workers and road users. Road users can access Mulgoa Road via the School House Road traffic lights.
- **Peter Court and Huron Place will be joined and open for two-way traffic with no parking from early 2024 and the right turn into Peter Court from Glenbrook Street will be closed** from early 2024. This is a permanent arrangement and will be in place even after construction is complete.
- **No parking on Hutchinson Crescent (parallel to Mulgoa Road)**, while construction is

underway **from 15 January 2024**.

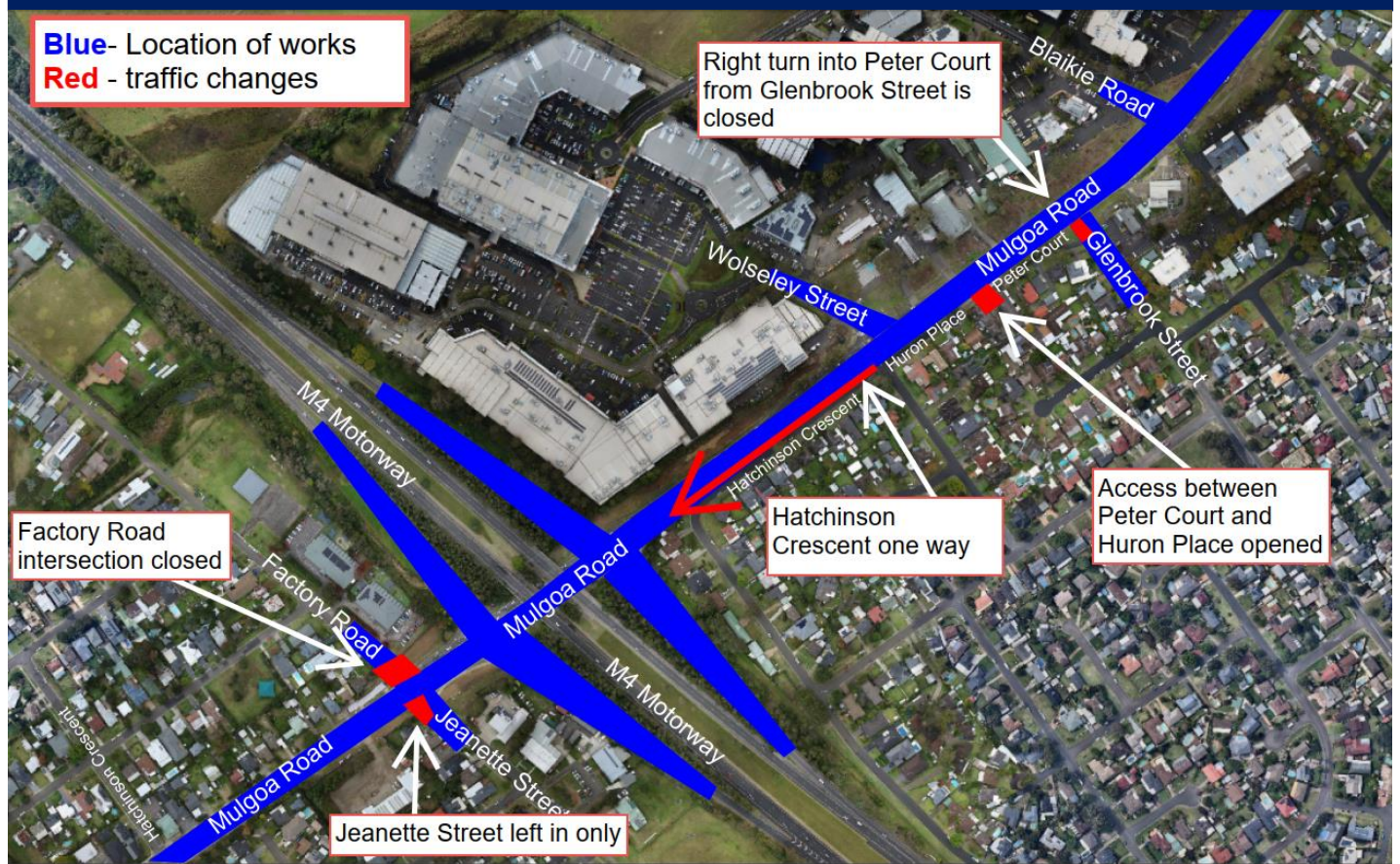
- **Hatchinson Crescent converted to a one-way street** for around one year **from 15 January 2024** to the start of 2025. This is to relocate utilities under Hatchinson Crescent, which requires closure of one side of the road.
- **A decision about making Hatchinson Crescent permanently one-way with street parking has not been made yet and is subject to discussion with Council.**

During the day, we will need to temporarily close lanes, with traffic switches in place, where road users would need to use different lanes along Mulgoa Road.

Road users are advised to comply with instructions from traffic controllers and utilise the available traffic lanes. Access to side streets, businesses, and residences will remain open. It is essential for drivers to adhere to the designated speed limits, follow the guidance provided by traffic controllers and signs, and stay updated on the latest traffic conditions by calling 132 701, visiting livetraffic.com, or downloading the Live Traffic NSW App.
