Night work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road – Thursday 6, Monday 10, Tuesday 11 and Thursday 13 July 2023

Transport for NSW will continue to carry out work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. Work is scheduled at night on 6, 10, 11, and 13 July 2023.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Drilling to test road conditions
- Using machinery in the road median
- Removing vegetation
- Restoring the worksite when work is finished.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, in the road median, at the corner of side streets and on the M4 east and west bound on and off ramps. (see map overleaf).

Working hours are **6pm to 5am on:**

- Thursday 6, Monday 10, Tuesday 11 and Thursday 13 July 2023.
- In case of bad weather, we will work on Friday 7 July, Wednesday 12 and/or Friday 14 July 2023.

Noisy work

We will be using machinery such as core drill, excavators, chainsaws, jackhammer, vibratory rollers, bobcat, a chipper, vacuum truck, other trucks for transporting material and saw cutting equipment. We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. There may be some vibration impacts from this work.

Our schedule of work

- Thursday 6 and 10 July Working on the road median between Jeanette Street and the M4. Road testing at the Wolseley Intersection. Tree clearing on M4 Westbound (WB) off-ramp. On Monday 10 July, additional utility investigations to take place on Wolseley Street and Blaikie Road.
- **Tuesday 11 July** Working on the road median between the M4 and Wolseley Street. Placing asphalt from Jeanette Street to the M4. Road testing at Blaikie Road intersection. Utility investigation on Blaikie Road and Wolseley Street.
- **Thursday 13 July** Working on the median between Wolseley Street and Blaikie Road. Placing asphalt from Jeanette Street to the M4. Road testing at Blaikie Road intersection.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.


One lane in each direction on Mulgoa Road will be closed to traffic, and one lane on the west and east bound on and off ramps will be closed, with traffic controllers on duty to guide vehicles.

Traffic changes

While we will try and minimise disruption to traffic, temporary traffic changes will be required at times to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place near our work area. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
