Changed traffic conditions for tree removal on the Mitchell Highway near Orange

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions on the Mitchell Highway, just east of Orange, from Monday 19 June for essential maintenance and safety work.

The work includes the removal of trees on Mitchell Highway after a routine inspection by an arborist found them to be in a poor condition from natural aging and decay. Removal of these trees will reduce the likelihood of future hazards and road closures on a 2.8 kilometre section of the highway between Gosling Creek and Dairy Creek Road.

Work hours will be between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and is expected to be completed in two weeks, weather permitting.

Changed traffic conditions including lane closures, intermittent stopping and reduced speed limits of 40km/h will be in place during work hours which may affect travel times.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work. Outside of work hours speed limits of 40, 60 or 80km/h will be in place.
