Ongoing work at Medlow Bath from 12 April 2023

Transport for NSW is continuing the Medlow Bath Upgrade with the first stage of work on the 1.2km upgrade of the Great Western Highway between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent now underway. The next stage of work is commencing from **Wednesday 12 April** and will include:

- Overnight installation of the section hut near Station Street on 12 and 13 April
- Continuing site compound establishment
- Tree clearing and grubbing
- Existing pavement saw cutting for utility and earthworks
- Utility potholing and relocations
- Commencement of earthworks and pavement work
- Property adjustment works
- Demolition of 106 Great Western Highway and Elsie Langford Centre
- Commencing stormwater drainage work
- Establishment work for a stockpiling site
- Continuation of construction of temporary sediment basin

We have included a map over the page to help explain the location of the work.

Work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**.

On **Wednesday 12 and Thursday 13 April**, the contractor will work **overnight** from **8pm to 5am**, weather permitting, to deliver and crane the new section hut into the railway corridor near Station Street. As part of the installation, the Telstra phone booth near Mazda will be out of order for 48 hours for safety reasons.

Overnight work will also be needed for tree clearing and saw cutting activities. The contractor will notify nearby residents when dates for these activities are confirmed.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. There is no planned work on Sundays and public holidays or over the Easter long weekend.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.


Pedestrian access may be temporarily disrupted, or we may need to establish detours along existing roads and pedestrian trails (such as the Great Blue Mountains Trail). We will liaise directly with impacted residents and businesses prior to the start of work.

Traffic changes

Traffic control may be in place where necessary for investigation work along the Great Western Highway during this time with reduced speed limits of 40km/h and temporary shoulder closures.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
