

McKanes Bridge at South Bowenfels closed to traffic on Wednesday 19 April

McKanes Bridge over the Coxs River on McKanes Falls Road at South Bowenfels will be closed to traffic on **Wednesday, 19 April** between **9am** and **3pm**, weather permitting, to facilitate the removal of temporary truss structures from the bridge.

Traffic will be detoured via Jenolan Caves Road and the Great Western Highway during works hours. We have included a map to show the detour.

This work is expected to take **one day** to complete, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Work will involve the use of machinery, which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off plant and machinery when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

For the safety of motorists and workers there will be a temporary detour in place between 9am and 3pm.

Traffic will be detoured via Jenolan Caves Road and the Great Western Highway during the works hours.

To enable machinery to safely leave the work site after the planned closure, traffic may be briefly stopped on Jenolan Caves Road to allow for turning vehicles; delays of up to five minutes may be expected.

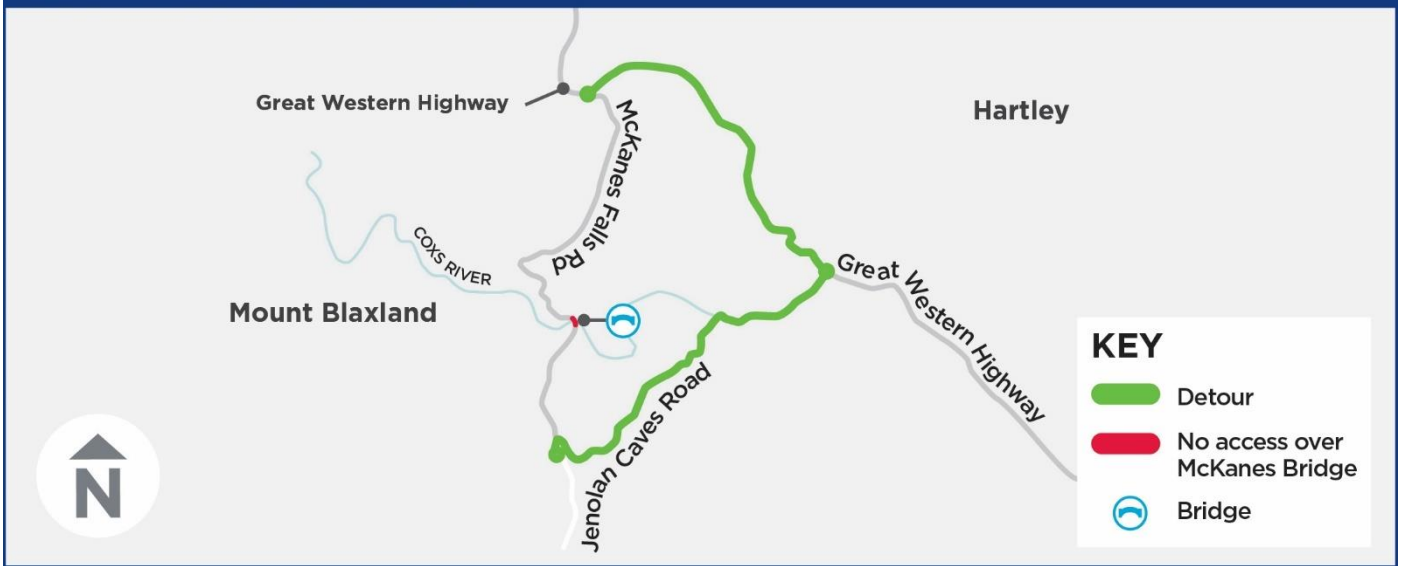
