Changed traffic conditions on Camp Street, Bridge Street and Flint Street in Forbes from Monday 8 May

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on Flint Street and the Camp Street Bridge approaches.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which includes heavy patching and resealing. This is temporary repair work following the November 2022 floods, and future pavement upgrade work will be carried out later in the year. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

Night work will be carried out from Monday to Thursday between **6pm** and **6am**, and day work on Friday between **8am** and **4pm**. We expect to complete this work in one week, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any other work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles during work hours.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Single lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place for the duration of works, which may affect travel times. Motorists should allow an extra ten-minutes travel time during this work.

During the work, there will be no access to Camp Street from Camp Lane, King Street, Sir Frances Forbes Drive or Gordon Duff Drive. There will be no access to Bridge Street from Hill Street, Flint Lane, or the northern end of Flint Street.

All motorists including residents will be required to use alternate accesses to Camp and Bridge Streets.

Light vehicles are encouraged to avoid the area and consider using Oxford Street between 8am and 4pm on Friday during the resealing works.


