

Nightworks with lane closures continue on the Mitchell Highway at Vittoria from Tuesday 13 June

The NSW Government is funding important safety work on the Mitchell Highway to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road as part of the Vittoria East and Vittoria Curve projects.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which includes asphaltting to provide an improved road surface. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working between **7pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday** and expect to complete this work in **six weeks**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any other work outside these times. Please note we will **not** be working the nights of **Sunday 11** and **Monday 12 June** due to the public holiday.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of motorists and our workers, this work will be taking place at night. There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and will direct lighting away from residences where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during the work hours and may affect travel times. Motorist should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.

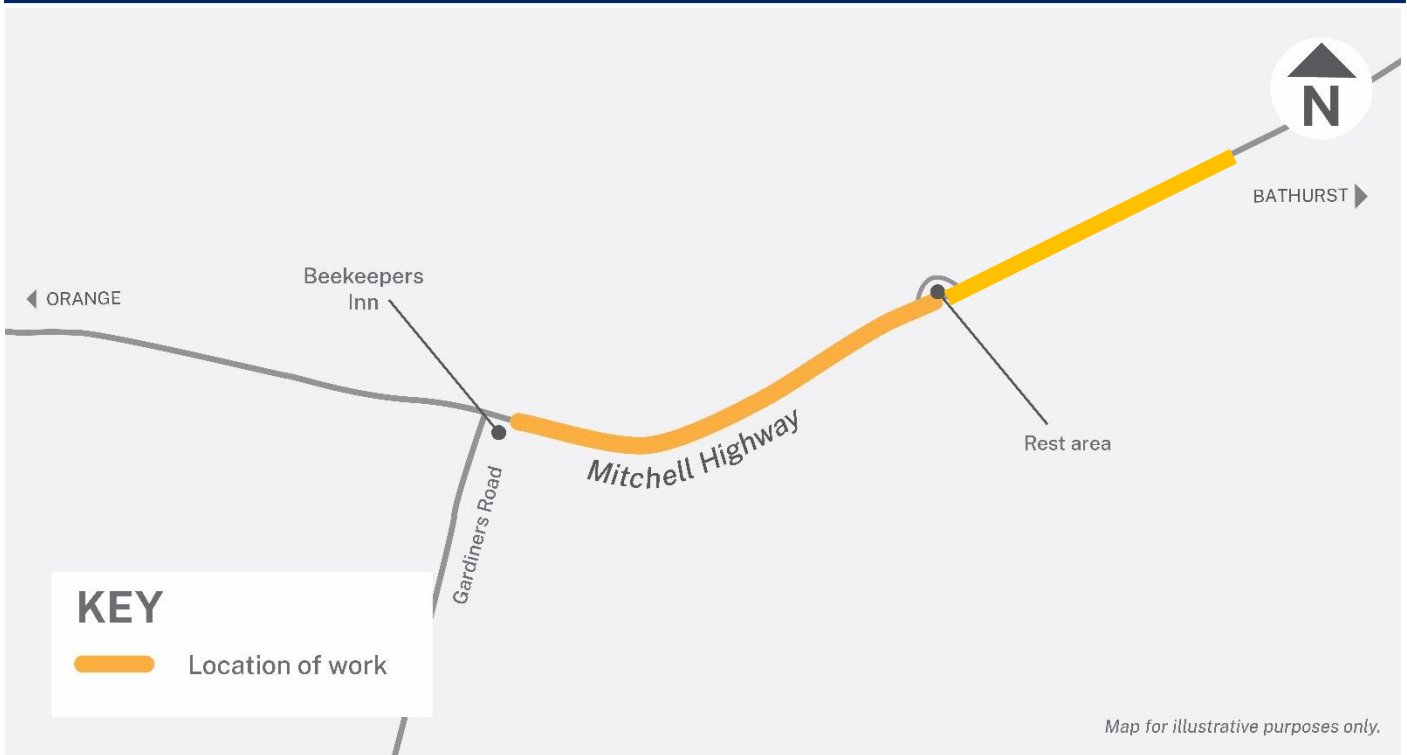
