

Ongoing essential maintenance work between Mendooran and Coonabarabran

Warrumbungle Council is carrying out essential maintenance work on behalf of Transport for NSW.

We are working at Wattle Springs between Mendooran and Coonabarabran.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Culvert extensions in 3 locations
- Vegetation clearing on the roadside
- Batter reshaping

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Lane closures and reduced speed limits
- Noise from machinery and equipment

Where and when we'll be working

Works will be carried out for 2km along Coonabarabran Road, from 47km to 49km north of Mendooran, approaching the Newell Highway towards Coonabarabran.

Works are ongoing and will continue until **31 August 2023**.

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. We have included a map to show the area of the work.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

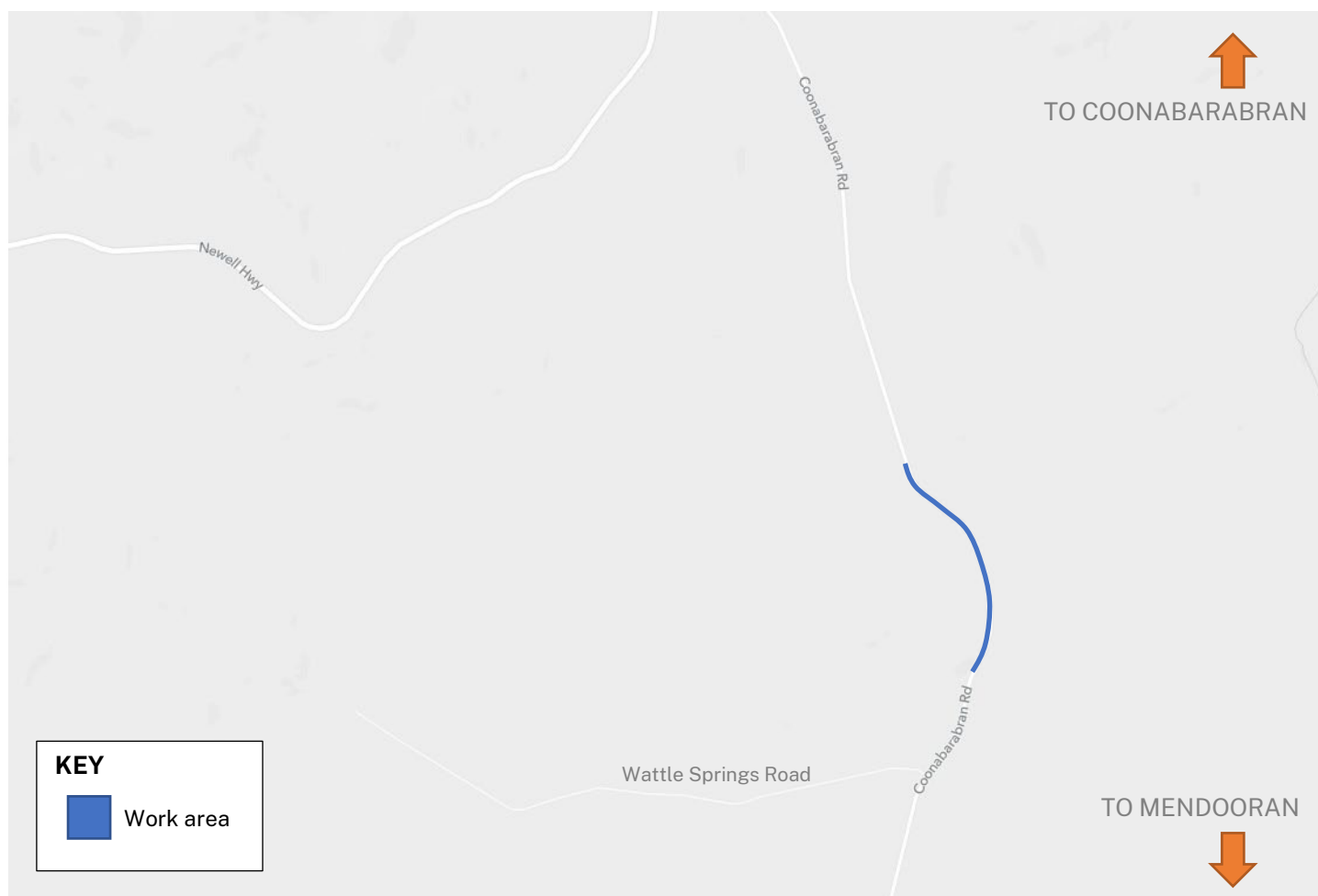
A 60km/h speed limit will be in place outside work hours.

Motorists should allow up to 5 minutes extra travel time during this work.
