

# Work continues at Little Hartley

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

### What work are we doing?

Earthworks and construction activities will continue across the site over the **next six to eight weeks** including:

#### East of Coxs River Road to Baaners Lane

- Drilling and piling for a future retaining wall will continue.
- Installing rock-fall fencing
- Building sediment basins
- Installing drainage and plumbing
- Bridge building, including concrete pouring.

#### West of Baaners Lane

- Vegetation removal and general earthworks

### Around Browns Gap Road

- Building a future carpark
- Vegetation removal.
- General earthworks.

### When and where we'll be working

We will continue working under our standard working hours between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**.

Should we need to do work outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.

### What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you will notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Plant movement in and out of the project site
- Traffic control and reduced speed limits in place. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

### Managing our impacts

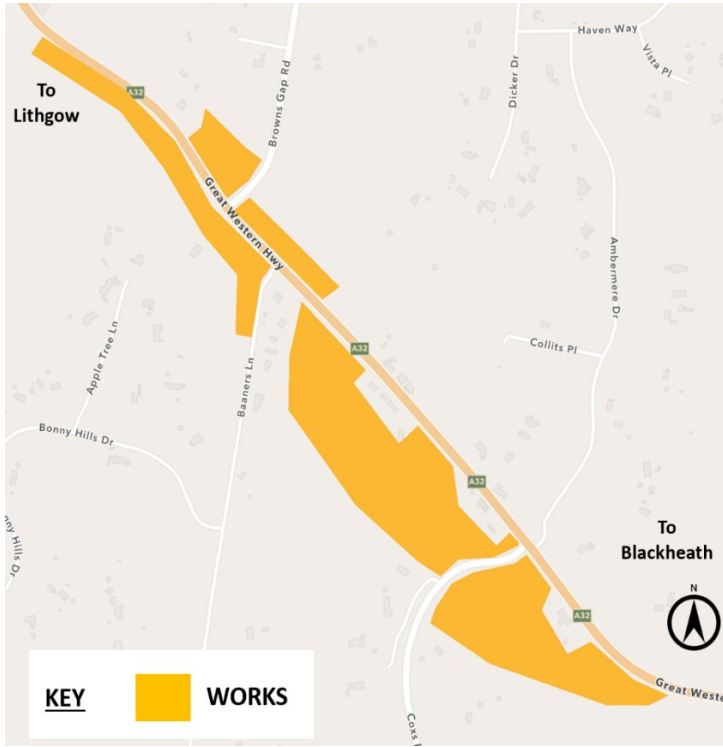
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.
