Newcastle Inner City Bypass – Rankin Park to Jesmond

Site compound off Platt Street, Waratah

The Australian and NSW Governments are funding construction of a 3.4 kilometre section of the Newcastle Inner City Bypass between Rankin Park and Jesmond, to the west of the John Hunter Hospital. Transport for NSW has engaged Fulton Hogan to finalise the design and construct this section of the bypass.

Establishing a site compound

A site compound is being established at the rear of the Mater Hospital in the disused reservoir, adjacent to the current staff overflow parking area. The compound will accommodate site sheds to house project staff, amenities and meeting spaces. There will also be around 100 parking spaces.

From Monday 14 to Wednesday 30 November we will be connecting the site to utilities including water, sewer and electricity.

Details of planned work

How will the work affect you?

Properties in Villa Road, Waratah West may experience a short interruption to water, sewer or electricity while we connect the site sheds in the site compound. This would be a one-off interruption of no more than an hour for each service. If a short outage is required, we will doorknock impacted properties prior to the outage occurring.

Critical need for services

We would also like to understand any specific requirements of residents living on Villa Road that could be impacted by these short outages, for example critical medical equipment or machines, or other business needs.
