

First stage begins to restore full road access at Cambewarra Mountain

Repairs begin on first of seven landslip sites

May 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wodi Wodi people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport is working to repair landslip damage that will make Moss Vale Road more resilient to the impacts of future severe weather events.

Work begins on **Wednesday 17 May 2023** to repair the first of seven landslip sites on Cambewarra Mountain.

What work are we doing?

Transport has engaged specialist contractors who will supply qualified workers and equipment to complete these repairs.

The work includes:

- removing loose rocks, soil and trees from the site
- installing 'soil nails' (long metal rods) that will add strength to the damaged slope
- applying 'geomesh' (a layer of high strength wire mesh and durable turf mat underlay) to stabilise the slope and retain surface material.

When and where we'll be working

Work will begin on site 28, which is the first of seven sites (see the map on the next page).

Start: **Wednesday 17 May 2023**

End: **Wednesday 7 June 2023**, weather permitting

Working hours are **7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday nights**.

What will this mean for you?

You may experience:

- increased travel times during work hours as the road will be closed in both directions
- minor traffic delays outside the work hours as this section of road will remain limited to single lane only with traffic control and speed restrictions
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

Transport has developed a plan to complete work on site 28 to minimise the impacts on residents and traffic.

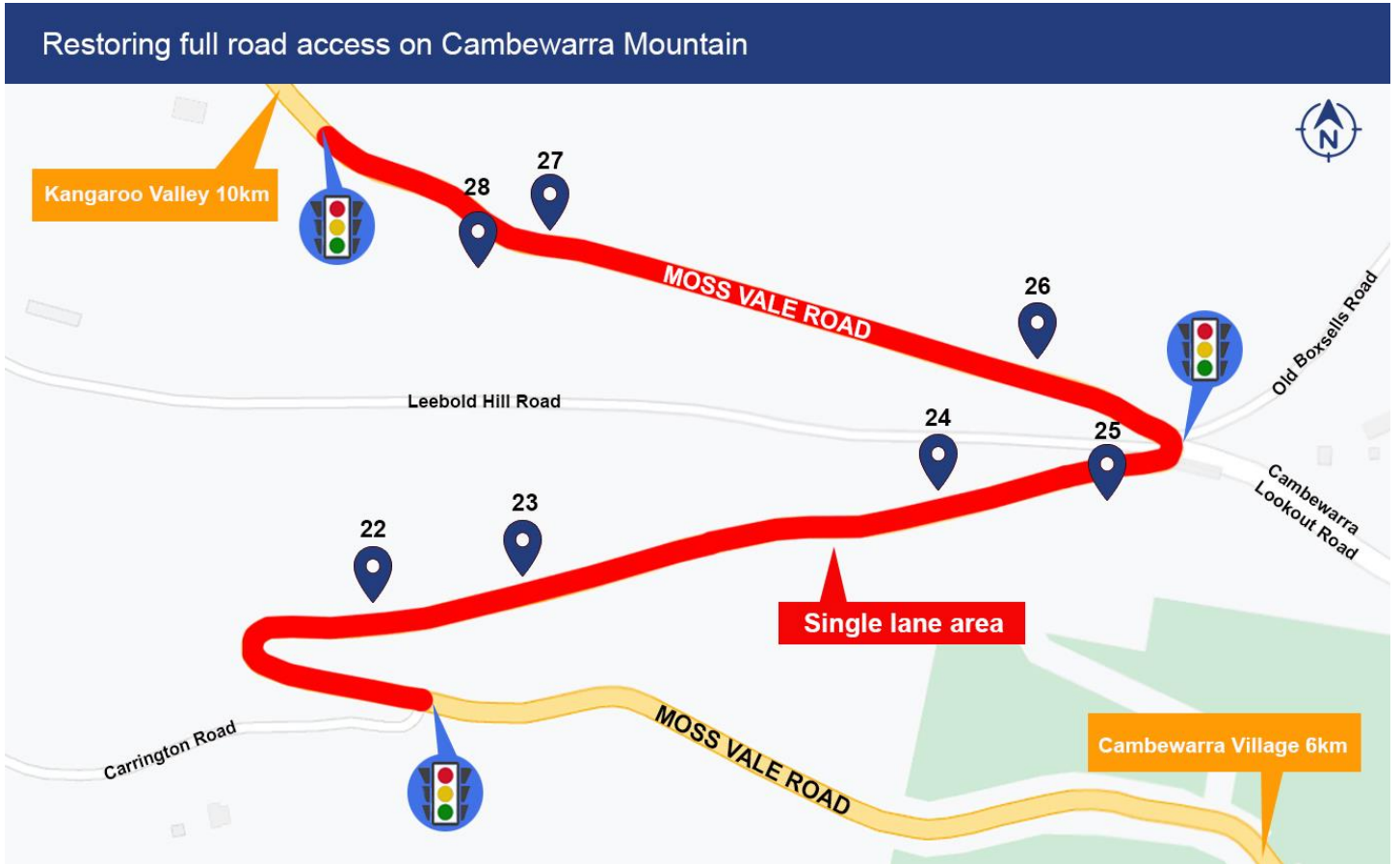
This includes:

- working at night (7pm to 5am) to minimise impact on peak traffic times
- working through the week (Sunday to Thursday nights) to avoid impact on weekend traffic
- stopping work regularly (start of each hour, beginning at 8pm) to provide traffic access through the work site during work hours
- always giving priority access to emergency services.

The current single lane access will be in place outside of work hours.

Next steps

Our specialist geotechnical engineering consultants have submitted designs for repairs on the remaining six sites on Cambewarra Mountain (sites 22 to 27).

We aim to begin a tender process as soon as possible to secure contractors for this work

We will keep the community informed as work progresses.
