What is planned

The Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park on Edgbaston Road will feature:

- A multi-storey commuter car park with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces
- Lift and stairwell access to each level
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage for safety and security
- Provision for future electric vehicle charging points
- Park&Ride infrastructure (Opal card-operated boom gates)
- Upgrade of existing stairs linking the existing car park to King Georges Road
- Four additional accessible parking spaces located on Tooronga Terrace
- · Landscaping.

What work are we doing?

Work in September will include:

- Tower crane installation
- In-ground services installation in the building footprint

- Installation of pavement for the car park ground floor and of vertical elements including columns and retaining walls
- Concrete works for Level 1 slab
- Delivery of plant and materials to site via Melvin Street
- Installation of cables from the new carpark site to the platform building.

When and where we'll be working

Working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.

Out of hours work will be from 6am to 6pm, Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 September.

We are working in and around the existing car park at 2-2a Edgbaston Road, as shown on the map over the page.

Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times. We have put measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using nontonal reversing beepers for trucks used on site.



Changes to parking

From 14 September two parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable until the end of the year near the cul-de-sac in Melvin Street outside number 56. Parking at the cul-de-sac near the rail access gate is also unavailable. This change is to allow safe access to site for large delivery vehicles. We apologise for any inconvenience caused to local residents.


The existing Edgbaston Road public car park is closed to commuters during construction of the
