



Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

Community notification

October 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient and enjoyable transport option.

What is happening?

As we build the active transport link, some trees and vegetation need to be removed along Denman Avenue at Caringbah. Please see the map overleaf.

As construction progresses, we will work with the arborist to avoid impacting tree roots. We will safely prune roots to retain trees where possible.

We had planned to remove trees and vegetation in three stages, with stage 1 recently completed and the final stage to be completed in early 2024.

We are now able to complete stages 2 and 3 from 30 October to late November 2023, weather permitting, and then continue path installation work.

Replanting and landscaping

We are committed to replacing four trees for every one that needs to be removed during construction of the active transport link, this is a 4:1 ratio.

The new trees on Denman Avenue will be planted to screen the railway corridor. At maturity many of these trees will grow up to 20 metres. Trees planted under the powerlines will grow up to 5 metres.

Replanting will occur in the first half 2024.

Tree species to be replanted

Tree species have been selected in consultation with Sutherland Shire Council to suit local conditions.

The native species include Lilly Pilly, Sydney Red Gum, Grey Myrtle, Bottlebrush, Christmas Bush, Lemon Scented Tea Tree and Flax Leaved Paperbark.

When we'll be working

Our work hours are from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve:

- setting up traffic controls including temporary lane closures
- temporarily modifying pedestrian access
- establishing safe access at the work site
- removing overhead branches, trees and tree stumps and chipping.

Our work will be noisy at times. Chipping will be completed in stages.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to the speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Parking changes

There will also be temporary removal of on-street parking of both sides of Denman Avenue. This will enable us to create a safe working area with temporary lane changes in place. We will be in

contact with residents to advise of changes to parking, and signage will be in place in advance to advise motorists of the changes.

We will return on-street parking to the community as soon as we can.
