Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Great Western Highway from south of Bellevue Crescent to Station Street, and on Railway Parade, as part of the Medlow Bath Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Construction is progressing and our next stage of work includes:

- Ongoing construction of the retaining walls, south of Bellevue Crescent
- Continuing utility work on Railway Parade near Sheila Street
- Building the car park and footpath in front of Medlow Bath Park and minor road work
- Installing a sewer main in Station Street
- Carrying out stormwater drainage work, earthworks and pavement work
- Finishing property adjustment work
- Building the sediment basin
- Ongoing construction of the pedestrian bridge, stairs, lifts and station services
- Nightwork to install or relocate utilities and carry out line marking in Railway Parade.

When and where we'll be working

Work will continue from **12 December**.

Day work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturday**.

Nightwork hours will be between **6pm and 7am, Monday to Friday** for no more than two nights in a row, and no more than three nights in a week.

We will continue to notify affected stakeholders about upcoming night work and discuss additional noise mitigation measures with them that may help reduce the impact of the work.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of our work activities.

As previously notified, there is also upcoming weekend work (daylight hours) at Medlow Station and the Pedestrian Bridge as part of a railway shutdown on the 9 and 10 December.

Construction shutdown during Christmas, New Year and Australia Day

Construction sites will close from **6pm Friday 22 December 2023** until **7am Monday 8 January 2024**.

Construction sites will close for the Australia Day public holiday from **6pm Thursday 25 January** until **7am Monday 29 January 2024**.

Periodic checks will take place to ensure the site is secure and maintained during these closures.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Providing a pedestrian pathway along Railway Parade.
- Turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages to minimise impacts to nearby residents.
- Installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible.



- Liaising with directly affected residents prior to nightwork commencing.
- Maintaining access to properties at all times.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control will be in place, including detours, stop/slow operations (temporary traffic lights) and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h along sections of the highway and Railway Parade. Traffic control will be in place, including detours and stop/slow operations (temporary traffic lights). Sections of the road will be closed where

necessary to allow work to be carried out safely on Railway Parade.

Road users, including pedestrians and school children, are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
