

Vegetation clearing and investigations at landslip sites

Natural disaster recovery

December 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wodi Wodi people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will remove vegetation and carry out investigations in preparation for future natural disaster recovery work on Moss Vale Road.

What work are we doing?

The work includes removing vegetation and trees at landslip sites on Barrengarry and Cambewarra mountains where repairs are being planned.

Transport will also carry out investigations to help with designing solutions to repair landslip damage on Barrengarry Mountain.

This will involve drilling into the road embankment to obtain geological samples.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be clearing vegetation on Moss Vale Road on **Sunday 10 December**, weather permitting. This work will occur at Barrengarry Mountain from **4pm to 6pm** and then at Cambewarra Mountain between **6pm and 5am**.

The geotechnical drilling investigations are planned at four locations west of the Barrengarry Mountain rest area from **Monday 11 December to Friday 15 December, 7am to 5pm**, weather permitting.

The map on the next page shows the location of the work areas.

What will this mean for you?

There will be some noise and traffic impacts from this work. You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic control and signs at work sites to manage lane closures and speed limits
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage the impact of our work has on the community and motorists. This includes:

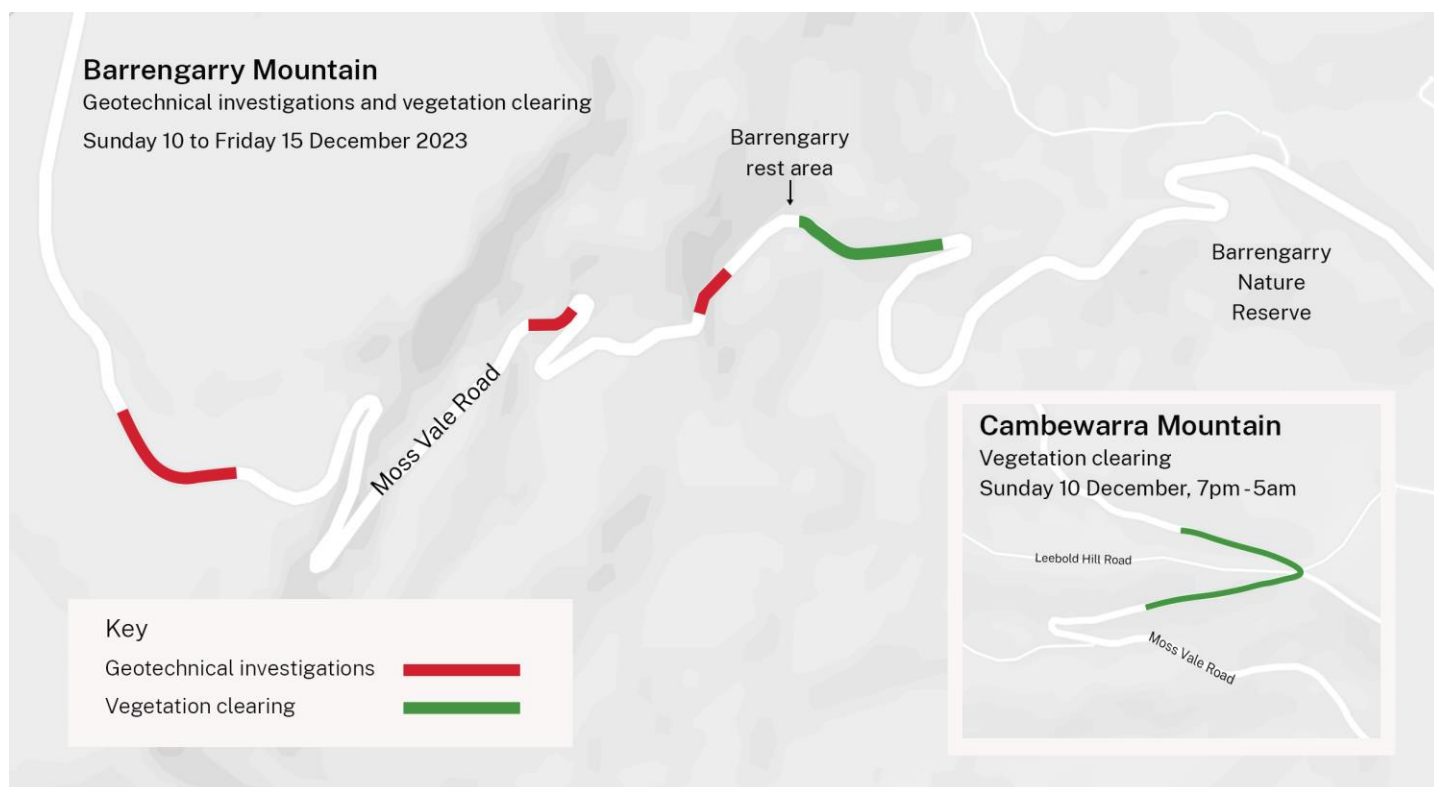
- only operating machinery when necessary to reduce noise as much as possible
- working at night when possible to minimise impact on traffic
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill.

Transport identified a total of 50 landslip sites on Moss Vale Road at Barrengarry and Cambewarra mountains following record-breaking rainfall in 2022.

Since the initial damage occurred, Transport has completed more than 130,000 work hours across multiple sites on Moss Vale Road and completed repairs at 24 of the 50 sites.
