Transport for NSW is delivering the Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park, with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and to help ease the congestion on our roads.

What is planned?

The Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park on Edgbaston Road will feature:

- A multi-storey commuter car park with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces
- Lift and stairwell access to each level
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage for safety and security
- Provision for future electric vehicle charging
- Park&Ride infrastructure
- Upgrade of existing stairs linking the existing car park to King Georges Road
- Four additional accessible parking spaces located on Tooronga Terrace

What work are we doing?

During December 2023 and January 2024 work will include:

- Concreting work including pouring car park floor and stairs
- Construction of accessible parking spaces in Tooronga Terrace
- High voltage electrical works along Hampden Street and Edgbaston Road.

When and where we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.**

While we plan for all concreting work to be in standard working hours, some work may run overtime on rare occasions in the advent of unexpected delays. In such circumstances concrete pouring will finish before 7pm and finishing works by 8pm.

Our site will close for the Christmas and New Year period from Friday 22 December 2023 with work resuming on Monday 8 January 2024. Security will be actively monitored.

All work is subject to site and weather conditions and may change without further notice.

Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times. We have put measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used on site.

Changes to parking


The existing Edgbaston Road public car park is closed to commuters during construction of the new commuter car park. The map below will help to identify suitable timed, untimed and disability parking, which provides access to the town centre and railway station.

In Tooronga Terrace, two accessible parking spaces and up to 30 public parking spaces are temporarily closed until mid to late-December for construction of the new accessible parking spaces. Alternative parking is available at Morgan Street. From mid-January 2024, electrical work will be completed on Hampden Street and Edgbaston Road. This will involve temporary loss of some parking spaces.
