

This document creates Rules for the purposes of clause 70 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2017. It is a condition of an authority that an examiner or proprietor must comply with the Rules.

### AIS Notice 42

### Using Application for Registration forms, AUVIS and HVAIS

August 2023

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this notice is to:

- Advise that HVAIS authorised examiners must complete an Application for Registration form when performing an establish registration inspection for trailers and heavy vehicles.
- Provide instructions to AUVIS and HVAIS examiners on the use of an Application for Registration form.

## **Background**

Previously, the <u>AIS Business Rules</u> did not require HVAIS examiners to complete page 3 of an <u>Application for Registration form (1009)</u> when conducting establish registration inspections and issuing manual HVAIS reports.

However, certain details necessary for the vehicle's registration establishment are not captured in a manual HVAIS report.

# **Changes**

HVAIS examiners **must** complete all relevant information on page 3 of an Application for Registration together with a manual HVAIS inspection report when conducting an establish registration inspection.

AUVIS and HVAIS examiners must have an understanding of the instructions below to complete the critical information found on this form.
