


Traffic changes at Noller Parade, Parramatta from Monday 17 July 2023

July 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands for this project and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering a new section of cycleway on Alfred Street, Parramatta between George Street and Noller Parade.

The new cycleway connection will provide a continuous north-south cycleway along Alfred Street Paramatta. It will link the proposed cycleway on Alfred Street south of George Street, to the Alfred Street Bridge, which is currently under construction.

What is happening?

Work commenced on the Alfred Street Cycleway Integration project in June 2023. In our start of works notification (May 2023), we advised that a new raised bike and pedestrian crossing will be installed at Noller Parade as part of the project.

To safely install the new crossing, we will need to close Noller Parade at Alfred Street for **up to three nights** between **Monday 17 July** and **Friday 21 July**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between 8pm and 5am.

Traffic changes and detours

During the work, Noller Parade will be temporarily converted into a two way road, and detours will be in place.

Northbound Alfred Street traffic will be able to access Noller Parade via George Street

Southbound Alfred Street traffic will be able to access Noller Parade via Alfred Street and Hassall Street.

Access to properties on Noller Parade will be maintained at all times via George Street.

Further information on access changes to Noller Parade from Alfred Street and detour routes can be seen on the map overleaf.

The community will also be provided with notice of the road closure at least five days beforehand by Variable Message Boards located around the area.

What will this mean for you?

Things you may notice during construction:

- workers, vehicles and traffic controllers
- temporary changes to traffic, cycling and pedestrian access, including lane closures
- temporary reduced speed limits to 40km/hour
- temporary lighting
- noise and vibration from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption. We try to minimise the impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in
- using quieter equipment where possible
- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- using noise blankets where possible
- completing noisy work before midnight.


Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
