

Great Western Highway – Bus Stop temporary relocations

Medlow Bath Upgrade

August 2023







Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Medlow Bath Upgrade, between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent.

What work are we doing?

During our work on the Great Western Highway, we will need to temporarily move bus stops to ensure safety of motorists, passengers and workers as our worksites move. The work includes:

- Temporarily relocating bus stops a number of times, within 100m of their existing locations
- Relocating traffic barriers and installing traffic controls
- Installing signage for temporary bus stops
- Carrying out utility relocation work, stormwater, drainage, earthwork and pavement work
- Removing car spaces in front of the Hydro Majestic.

When and where we'll be working

Temporary relocations of the bus stops will commence from **4 September**, weather permitting, and will occur at various times during construction.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of bus stops.

Working hours will be **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday,** weather

permitting. We don't plan any work on Sundays or public holidays.

At times we will also be working at night between **6pm and 7am,** during which time we may relocate bus stops, with changes observed the following day.

We only work at night when necessary, to reduce traffic impacts and to ensure the safety of workers. We will notify affected residents ahead of any scheduled nightwork.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Bus stops on either side of the Great Western Highway moving, with pedestrian and passenger access maintained
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

We are working with the local bus provider for each of the temporary relocations. Updates on transportnsw.info will provide information to passengers. Please allow extra travel time when using the local buses during the work.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Providing signage of the temporary bus stops
- Working closely with the local bus provider
- Staging our work to minimise impacts and disruptions to residents and motorists.
