Transport for NSW pays respect to the Dharug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the upgrade at Medlow Bath, between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent.

What work are we doing?

Construction is progressing and our next stage of work includes:

- Constructing the retaining walls, south of Bellevue Crescent
- Installing barriers along the highway
- Removing trees on Railway Parade for utility work
- Installing drainage and utilities under railway and highway
- Installing new and relocating existing services
- Installing a sewer main in Station Street
- Removing the mural bus shelter from the highway and storing it until it can be relocated to Medlow Park
- Carrying out stormwater drainage work
- Carrying out earthworks and pavement work
- Ongoing tree clearing work
- Continuing property adjustment work
- Continued sediment basin construction.

When and where we'll be working

Work will continue under the standard approved working hours for the project between **7am and**

6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays, weather permitting.

We don't plan any work on Sundays or public holidays.

Nightwork will also continue to take place on weeknights between **6pm and 7am**. Nightwork is limited to three nights per week, and no more than two consecutive nights.

Nightwork activities will include pavement testing, stormwater drainage, utilities, tree and vegetation clearing, earthworks and pavement work.

The frequency of nightworks will change throughout the project. While there will be disruptive periods, there will also be quieter periods between different project stages.

We will notify affected residents and stakeholders before each period of night work commences.

Tree and vegetation clearing

Tree and vegetation clearing work will continue during the day and night during the winter months.

We acknowledge the visible difference the tree clearing has made in Medlow Bath since work began and we thank you for your patience as this continues.

If you are concerned about tree clearing and want information on landscaping plans, please reach out.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:



- Removal of parking on the highway in front of the Hydro Majestic and completion of new parking spaces at Railway Parade
- Ongoing work in Railway Parade
- The relocation of Australia Post box from the highway in front of the Hydro Majestic to the U-turn Bay at Railway Parade
- Traffic switches to allow for roadworks. The highway will remain open at all times.
- Impacts to pedestrian access or detours along existing roads and The Great Blue Mountains Trail shared path.
- Traffic controllers, traffic barriers and signage
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment in these ways:

- Keeping the highway open to traffic
- Arranging the work in stages
- Turning off machinery and vehicles not in use
- Mulching during the day to reduce night noise.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control, including stop/go, reduced speed limits and temporary shoulder closures may be in place where necessary. Detours or any other traffic changes will be notified separately. Road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.
