Transport Access Program Bellambi Station Upgrade

Community notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wodi Wodi and Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading accessibility at Bellambi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, aiming to provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage

Completed work

The new station building was opened to the public last month.

Work was done in preparation for a level crossing upgrade including tree removal and pit installation.

Upcoming work

In the coming months we will be:

- installing ramp screens featuring Aboriginal interpretations
- finalising new station services and station building work
- installing tactiles on the platform
- opening the new bike shelter and hoops to the public
- installing gates, fencing and signage
- regrading work

Out-of-hours work

Out-of-hours work will be carried out between **4am Saturday 1 July** and **6am Monday 3 July**. Work includes:

- platform resurfacing
- excavating and installing cables
- pouring concrete for new retaining wall
- installing drainage
- removing vegetation

For the safety of staff and customers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

Bellambi Lane, between Brompton Road and Francis Street, will be closed between **4am Saturday 1 July** and **4am Monday 3 July** for work to be carried out. Traffic control detours will be in place and pedestrian access will be maintained.

Respite vouchers may be offered to residents immediately surrounding the work areas if noise assessments show a higher-than-normal level of noise. Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, exercising respite periods during work and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Equipment being used includes excavators and delivery trucks, concrete trucks and pump, dump trucks and hand tools.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

The commuter car park will be closed for one week from **Wednesday 28 June** to **Wednesday 5 July** to enable the safe delivery of materials and for work to continue. The car park will be reopened to include the new bike shelter and hoops.
