Bellambi Station Upgrade

Community notification

May 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Woddi Woddi people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading accessibility at Bellambi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, aiming to provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage

Completed work

The pedestrian access ramp from the level crossing to the platform was removed over the Easter weekend, and a new accessible ramp was installed.

Work on the new station building continued with internal fixtures and external cladding, final work to the new bathrooms and station master's office and services partially installed inside the new station building.

Upcoming work

The new station building will be open to the public in May. Once the new building has been opened, the existing station building will be demolished. The platform will be open during this time with safety measures in place and signage to direct customers.

Custom-designed screens will be installed on the new ramp this month, and rubber panelling is also being installed at the level crossing on Bellambi Lane to remove the gap between rail and pedestrian surfaces.

Out-of-hours work

Out-of-hours work will be carried out between **4am Saturday 13 May** and **10pm Sunday 14 May**.

Work to be done during this time includes:

- demolishing the old station building slab, finalising the new ramp work and resurfacing part of the platform.
- installing rubber panelling at the level crossing on Bellambi Lane to remove the gap between rail and pedestrian surfaces.

For the safety of staff and customers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

Bellambi Lane will be closed between **4am Saturday 13 May** and **4am Monday 15 May** for work to be carried out. Traffic control detours will be in place and pedestrian access will be maintained.

Respite vouchers may be offered to residents immediately surrounding the work areas if noise assessments show a higher-than-normal level of noise. Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, exercising respite periods during work and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Equipment being used includes excavators and delivery trucks, concrete trucks and pump, dump trucks and hand tools.



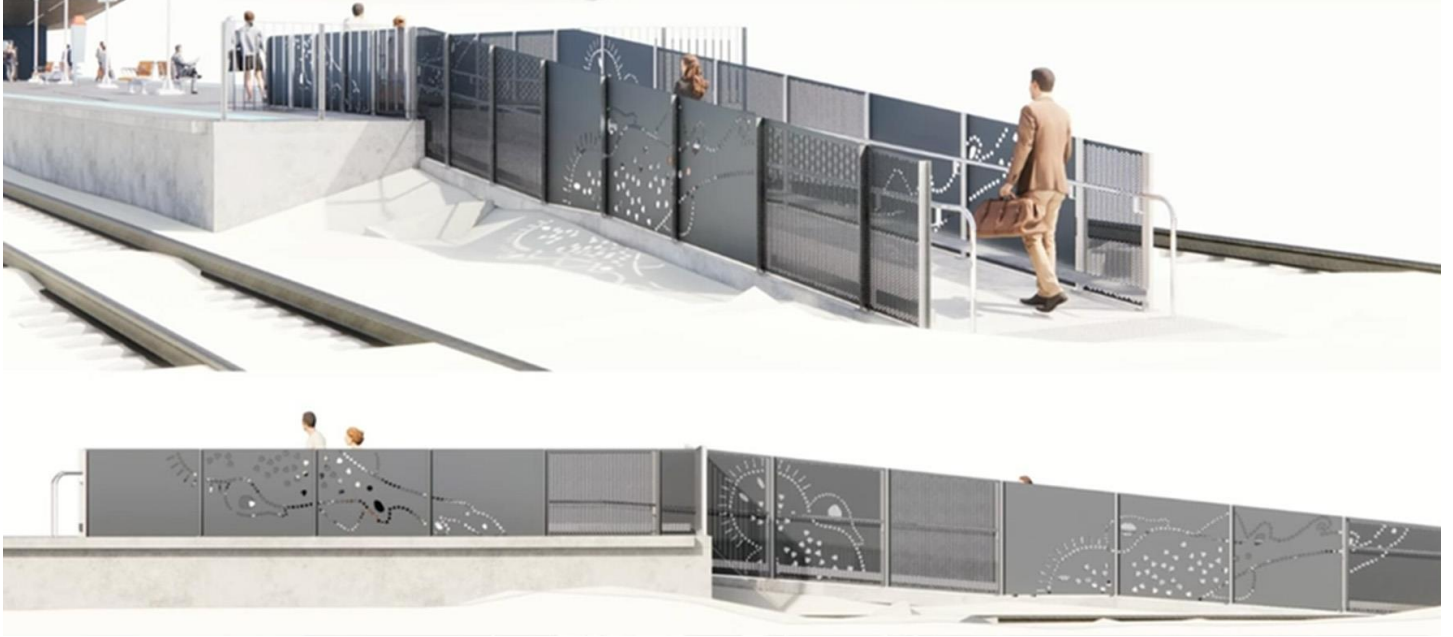
Working hours

Aside from weekend work mentioned above, normal working hours will continue from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Commuter car park

The commuter car park will be closed for one week from **Tuesday 9 May to Tuesday 16 May** to enable the safe delivery of materials and for work to continue.
