Transport Access Program Bellambi Station Upgrade

Community notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading accessibility at Bellambi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, aiming to provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage

Upcoming work

Upgrades to the level crossing at Bellambi Station will continue in October.

This month we will be installing VeloSTRAIL, a hard-wearing rubber product eliminating the gap between rail and pedestrian surfaces.

Other work includes:

- removing fencing and gates
- excavating
- installing drainage
- pouring concrete for retaining wall and footpaths
- installing pedestrian and emergency gates, tactiles, signage, new fencing, and access ramp
- line marking and resurfacing
- new cable routes and light poles
- installing noise barrier fencing
- landscaping.

Out-of-hours work

Out-of-hours work will be carried out between 6pm Friday 6 October and 6am Monday 9 October.

For the safety of staff and passengers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

Respite vouchers may be offered to residents immediately surrounding the work areas if noise assessments show a higher-than-normal level of noise. Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, exercising respite periods during work and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Equipment being used includes excavators and delivery trucks, concrete trucks and pump, dump trucks, lighting towers and hand tools.

Temporary traffic changes

We will be partially closing Bellambi Lane between Brompton Road and Francis Street, from **6pm Friday 6 October to 4am Saturday 7 October**.

A full road closure will also occur between **4am** Saturday 7 October and 4am Monday 9 October.

Traffic control will be in place and pedestrian access will be maintained.
