Changed traffic conditions on Duckmaloi Road from 20 March

Essential safety upgrade work is taking place on Duckmaloi Road.

Oberon Council will be carrying out the work which includes widening the shoulders, vegetation clearing, installing safety barriers, linemarking as well as the installation of vehicle activated signs, curve alignment markers and audio Tactile Line Marking (rumble strips) along a five kilometre section of Duckmaloi Road. We have included a map to show the location of work.

This work is expected to take **12 weeks** to complete, weather permitting, and will be carried out from **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 6pm**.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise this by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

Lane closures, intermittent stopping and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during work hours. Traffic control and reduced speed limits of 60km/h and 80km/h will be in place outside of work hours, until the work is complete.


