Project update

Holiday period shut down and return to work in January 2024

The Circular Quay Renewal project is progressing. Site investigation work has been going well and we will return in 2024 to complete the work. The work will finish for the year on Friday 22 December 2023.

The project and all site activity will pause and compounds will be temporarily demobilised for the holiday period.

There will be no project activity from Saturday 23 December 2023 to Sunday 7 January 2024.

Work will resume from Monday 8 January 2024 and will continue in early 2024.

The following site investigation work will be carried out in the new year:

- drilling boreholes into the ground
- installation of water quality monitors
- structural condition assessments of Circular Quay station buildings
- non-intrusive services investigations within the Circular Quay station buildings.

A range of mitigation measures will be in place to minimise impacts.

There will be further work carried out in 2024 to prepare for main work construction. We will continue to provide you with updates and engage directly with local stakeholders about work that may affect them.
