Bondi Junction to Sydenham track maintenance

From Friday 7 April to Tuesday 11 April 2023

What we're doing

Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works between Bondi Junction and Sydenham via Erskineville from Friday 7 April to Tuesday 11 April.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro's planned works are for the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse (ESR), with full closure of this area, as follows:

- Wall cladding
- Ceiling and tiling
- VE Steel and cladding install in public zones (primarily around lifts and stairs)

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Bridge refurbishment (paint) at Town Hall
- Drainage maintenance between Central and Bondi Junction
- Rerailing at Redfern and Martin Place
- Resleeping Polymer block between Erskineville and Redfern
- Resleeping works at Rushcutters viaduct and Art Gallery
- Routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Redfern, Erskineville and St James
- Track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Trackside signage and maintenance work at various locations
- Tunnel lighting upgrade works at Erskineville
- Turnout removal at Edgecliff
- Vegetation maintenance, litter, and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day and at night.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 2am Friday 7 April until 4am Tuesday 11 April.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Final (finishing) works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
