



Como Commuter Car Park

Start of work on site

June 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering a new commuter car park at Como Station as part of the NSW Government's Commuter Car Park Program.

The project will provide up to 34 new commuter car parking spaces to deliver more convenient access to public transport and help ease congestion on our roads. Stephen Edwards Constructions has been awarded the contract to construct the Como Commuter Car Park.

What work are we doing?

From **Monday 5 June 2023** site establishment for the construction of the Como Commuter Car Park is planned to commence. Activities on site throughout June will include:

- installation of a site compound and facilities for the workers within the site
- installation of environmental controls including tree protection measures, and erosion and sediment control measures
- vegetation trimming
- investigations for underground utilities
- earthworks including removal of soil and rock from the site.

Asbestos Removal

Preliminary site investigations have indicated that small fragments of bonded asbestos are likely to be encountered within the work area, which will need to be removed before work begins, along with the asbestos-containing soil.

A licenced asbestos removalist will be used for this work.

You may see workers wearing protective clothing to ensure their safety while handling and removing any asbestos fragments or asbestos-containing soil. Air monitoring will also be in place for the duration of these activities.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. At times work may be required to be undertaken at night, or during track closedowns, to ensure safety of the workers.

Residents will be notified when work outside standard construction hours is planned to take place.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Noise from machinery and equipment



Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimize the impacts where possible, including:

- Turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts
- Locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible

- Conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration, and dust management.
