Coniston Station Infrastructure Upgrade



More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program is upgrading the rail network to support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet.

As part of the program, we are completing work at Coniston Station to accommodate the new trains which will provide greater comfort and convenience for intercity customers.

What does 'Mariyung' mean?

Mariyung is the Darug word for Emu in acknowledgment of the local Aboriginal culture.

The Mariyung fleet will run through many Aboriginal Countries such as Darug country, as well as at final destinations in Wiradjuri Country in the west at Lithgow; Awabakal Country to the north at Newcastle and Dharawal Country to the south at Kiama.

What's been happening?

After pausing all construction activity as a result of NSW Government Public Health Orders and Restrictions at the end of July, we are now back on site and continuing our upgrade activities at Coniston Station.

Last month our activities included:

- excavation activities for the installation of underground routes to carry cable connections
- installation of cables to accommodate new platform lighting, CCTV and signalling infrastructure

All work will be carried out in line with current NSW Government Public Health Orders and Restrictions, which are subject to change.

What's next?

In September we will be:

- excavating underneath rail track for the installation of underground routes, cables and piping
- installing concrete bases and pre-cast cable pits to support new infrastructure
- installing new trackside equipment to improve signalling systems
- removal of redundant signalling infrastructure and installation of upgraded signalling equipment
- upgrading CCTV systems to improve safety and security

To do this work, we will be accessing the rail corridor through the rail access gates off Gladstone Avenue and Old Springhill Road.

Night work

In September, some activities are required to take place outside of standard construction hours (7am-6pm).

This work has been scheduled to take place during a Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

Work outside of standard construction hours is scheduled to take place between **6pm Friday 10 and 7am Monday 13 September.**

These times are subject to change as a result of NSW Government Public Health Orders and Restrictions.
