



T8 Airport Line Power Supply Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

September 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading the power supply to support an increase to the number of services operating through the T8 Airport Line tunnel and support the introduction of the new fleet of trains operating along the T8 Airport Rail Line.

What work are we doing?

During September 2023, work will continue to upgrade the power supply along the T8 Airport Line tunnel from Central to Wolli Creek Junction.

Work includes:

- cable, overhead wiring and utility installations inside the T8 Airport Line Tunnel
- oversized rail infrastructure deliveries to the Gibbons Street site access point in Redfern.

The map overleaf outlines the access point.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

We will be working inside the T8 Airport Line Tunnel and will use the site access point at Gibbons Street to load/unload materials and equipment.

All construction work is weather permitting and subject to change.

Out-of-hours deliveries and work

There will be several oversized out-of-hours deliveries made to the Gibbons Street site access point between **6pm and 5am from Tuesday 12 September to Friday 22 September 2023**.

For safety reasons some work will take place outside of standard construction hours when no trains are running **from 10pm Friday 15 September to 2am Monday 18 September 2023**.

The map overleaf shows the site access point.

What will this mean for you?

There will be **traffic changes on Gibbons Street** (between Marian and Regent streets) **between 9pm and 5am from Tuesday 12 September to Thursday 21 September 2023** to allow oversized deliveries to access the work area.

Traffic changes include:

- the inside lane travelling northbound along Gibbons Street will be closed during the times outlined above
- traffic control will be in place to direct motorists to merge into the two northbound lanes that will remain open. Please refer to the map overleaf.

You may also notice:

- workers and vehicles in and near the site access point
- noise from machinery and equipment.
