## **Vegetation removal at Little Hartley from Monday 31 October**

Together, the Australian Government and NSW Government have committed more than \$2.5 billion towards the East and West sections of the Great Western Highway Upgrade, between Katoomba and Blackheath, and between Little Hartley and Lithgow, respectively.

Transport for NSW (Transport) will be carrying out vegetation removal at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade early works program, as part of the Great Western Highway Upgrade Program.

Contractors for Transport will carry out the work, which will include tree clearing, grubbing and grass slashing along the Great Western Highway and on Coxs River Road, Baaners Lane and Browns Gap Road, Little Hartley. The approximate work area is included in the map attached.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday 31 October** to **Wednesday 6 December 2022**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

## How will the work affect you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on local residents.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

We will continue to keep you informed as planning on the project progresses.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control may be in place where necessary, with temporary lane closures and reduced speed limits of 40km/h on the Great Western Highway, Coxs River Road, Baaners Lane and Browns Gap Road when required.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
