Croom - Weekend Rail Corridor Work

More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network. In order to improve train services for customers on the south coast, platform extensions and asset upgrades are required at a number of stations along the T4 Illawarra Line.

What's happening?

Between **4pm Friday 30 September and 7am Saturday 1 October 2022**, we will be working inside the rail corridor around Croom Substation to adjust the location of one overhead wiring weight.

This work has been scheduled to take place between during a Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

What you'll notice

We will be delivering a telehandler via flatbed truck to the site, where we will have a small team working to relocate the weight.

Access to the site will be via the existing corridor access gates on College Avenue.

New Mariyung Fleet

The introduction of a new fleet will provide improved customer safety, accessibility, and comfort. This fleet has been called 'Mariyung', the Durug word for Emu, in acknowledgement of the local Aboriginal culture.
