# **Crowdy Head Boat Harbour Upgrade**

### Community Update - June 2023

The NSW Government is delivering major improvements to maritime infrastructure and facilities statewide, to help the boating and wider community safely access, use and navigate our inland and coastal waters.

#### **Background**

Crowdy Head Boat Harbour is an important harbour on the mid-north coast for boat users, as it is a safe and accessible harbour with no river mouth or coastal bars to cross.

The eastern Jetty (Jetty 1) is nearing the end of its useful life, beyond repair and needs replacement. The western Jetty (Jetty 2) has been out of service since 2010 and will be removed.

In December 2020, the NSW Government announced maritime stimulus funding to upgrade the berthing infrastructure of Crowdy Head Boat Harbour.

In June 2022 the concept design and Review of Environmental Factors (REF) was displayed for community comment.

We would like to thank the community for attending the information sessions for this project and contributing to feedback during the "Have your say" process which closed on the 15 July 2022.

As a result of valuable feedback received during this consultation process, a number of design options are being investigated to ensure the most suitable design is selected.

This includes a detailed review of jetty

- Obtain final approval for the project
