



# Start of Stage 3 for Denmark Link Road works from 28 August

## Denmark Link upgrade

August 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Denmark Link Road upgrade to reduce congestion and provide an alternate local connection to light vehicles.

We previously notified the community that we would be carrying out work from 12 June. However, Stage 3 work will now start on 28 August.

From **Monday 28 August**, we will be starting major work for Stage 3. This will include utility relocations, subsoil drainage, bulk earthworks stabilisation, base course and kerbing.

Denmark Road will be closed in full for approximately four weeks between the access road connecting to Creek Street and up to Garfield Road West.

Access to residential properties, livestock (horse carts) and businesses will always be maintained.

### What work are we doing?

We will carry out the following works:

- demolish the existing road pavement and replace it with new pavement
- construct new drainage systems
- utility adjustments
- kerb and gutter construction

### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance to surrounding residents and businesses by using non-tonal beepers on reversing vehicles and turning off machinery when not in use. Equipment used for these activities include heavy and light vehicles, rollers, excavators, graders, bobcats and hand and power tools.

### Our work schedule

We will be working between Denmark Road, West Parade, Trevithick Street and Carlton Street from Monday 28 August as we continue upgrading the roads. This work will be carried out during the day.

Our work hours are 7am - 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

### Traffic changes

As we are commencing upgrade works in front of properties on Denmark Road, there will be temporary changes to access for some residents.

Burton Contractors will contact affected residents individually to explain the changes and how it will affect you.

Timed traffic lights will be in place to ensure safe flow of traffic and construction vehicles. Please follow the signs and traffic controllers' directions.
