


Night works on Garfield Road West from 12 November

Denmark Link Road Upgrade

November 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Denmark Link Road is a new link road being constructed between Garfield Road West, Riverstone, and the Westminster Street Bridge at Schofields.

The new link road aims to address traffic congestion along Garfield Road West around the railway level crossing at Riverstone. It will provide an alternate local connection for light vehicles to cross the Richmond railway line and avoid the Riverstone town centre.

What work are we doing?

As part of the upgrade works, we will be removing the top layer of asphalt and replacing it with a new layer at the intersection of Garfield Road West and Denmark Road from **Sunday 12 November to Friday 15 December**.

We will work up to a maximum of five night shifts in a week and work up to a maximum of ten night shifts over this period. We will not work on Saturday nights.

We will wait a week before resuming line marking work which would take up additional five night shifts to complete.

When and where we'll be working

We will need to carry out most of the work at night to reduce traffic disruption.

The night work will be carried out on Garfield Road West between Pacer Street and Creek Street between 7pm to 6am from Sunday 12 November to Friday 15 December.

What will this mean for you?

Equipment used for these activities include heavy and light vehicles, profiler trucks, line marking trucks, rollers, excavators, graders, bobcats and hand and power tools.

We will lessen any noise disturbance as much as possible by:

- monitoring noise periodically so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required
- using non-tonal beepers on reversing vehicles
- turning off machinery when not in use
- using noise blankets to reduce noise where possible
- completing the noisiest activities such as saw cutting and jackhammering by midnight

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Motorists are advised to follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
