More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, 'turn up and go' services for many customers.

The work we are completing at Dapto Station will support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet, a new fleet of intercity trains that will offer improved safety, accessibility and comfort for customers travelling on the T4 Illawarra Line.

As part of the program, we are extending platforms, upgrading infrastructure and re-building the maintenance depot at Dapto Station.

Transport Access Program

The Transport Access Program is another NSW Government initiative delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

As part of the program, we are upgrading the level crossing, pedestrian zone, installing a formal kiss-and-ride zone, widening Platform 1, regrading Platform 2 and upgrading the station bathrooms, waiting room, footpaths, kerbs and ramps.

What have we completed?

Our construction team has reached several milestones at Dapto station. To date we have:

- completed piling and concrete work for the platform extension on Platform 1, 2 and 3
- installed structural steel on Platform 3 canopy
- carried out civil work for the new track extension and installed new track
- modified the heritage building and relocated the Opal top-up machine into the new waiting room
- widened Platform 1
- poured concrete for the new kiss-and-ride zone
- finished the upgrade to the male ambulant toilet
- completed footpath work.

What's next at Dapto?

In the coming months we are expecting to complete several construction activities at Dapto. Our work will involve:

- installing a steel canopy on Platform 1
- completing construction activities on the maintenance depot including external brick work, window and solar system installation
- removing hoarding on Platform 2 to allow installation of new drainage and fencing
- completing upgrades to signalling infrastructure
- finishing platform extension work including asphalting and tactile paving
- carrying out minor resurfacing work to the commuter car park entrance
- installing light pole and low voltage work
- closing the entry to the station from Bong Bong Road in December for three weeks for demolition. All changes will be signposted
- starting landscaping, painting, and line marking work
- closing the Family Accessible Toilet for about two weeks to allow compliance changes to be made. A temporary ambulant toilet will be available and signposted
- installing electrical and communications containment on Platform 2
- lighting and painting upgrade work
- installing seats in the forecourt and relocating seating on Platform 2
- carrying out electrical containment and lighting work on Platform 1
- adjusting handrails to the entry ramp on Platform 1.

Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours on this project are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Upcoming weekend work

In December, some of our work is scheduled to be completed outside standard construction hours. We will be completing work on these dates:

- From 6pm Friday 2 December until 7am Monday 5 December
- From 7am until 6pm on Saturday 10 December.

Weekend work has been scheduled to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running. This minimises disruptions to commuter services and improves the safety of construction team and customers.

We will contact you directly if out of hours work is anticipated to be noticeable at your address.

Holiday and shutdown period

We will be continuing our construction activities until Wednesday 21 December.

A shutdown period will occur from Thursday 22 December 2022 until Sunday 8 January 2023. This means no construction activities will take place during this time.
