The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Denistone Station customers, with an upgraded station accessible to all.

Work completed

Work is progressing well at Denistone Station. We recently completed the lift shaft and brickwork.

When we'll be working


Work hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm, Saturday.

What work are we doing?

In May and June 2023, we will:

- install steelwork and solar panels for new platform boarding access zone canopies
- install a power pole and kiosk to power the new lifts

- paint and re-tile the existing waiting rooms, modify to main station building awning and adjust the station staircase step height and handrails
- install accessible ramp to waiting room, new unisex toilet on Platform 1 and 2, and two new lift carts
- line mark, relocate bike racks and install new accessible footpath to the station at the Gordon Crescent public carpark
- reinstate heritage facade of station building, by reinstalling the heritage timber boards
- upgrade drainage and install drainage grates in front of existing platform buildings
- resurface and relevel half of the platforms for a better customer experience.





Out-of-hours work in June 2023

From 2am Saturday 10 June until 2am Tuesday 13 June there will be out-of-hours work during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork on the long weekend. During this work:

- a train replacement bus service will be available
- the Gordon Crescent station overbridge and parts of West Parade, East Parade and Ryedale Road will be closed to vehicles. Traffic detours will be in place and some on-street parking will be affected. Please follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers during this period.

We will provide more information about this work in early-June 2023.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles around the station
- traffic controllers and signage
- road closures, reduced speed limits, footpath closure during out-of-hour work
- pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- Gordon Crescent car park continues to be temporarily closed until early-May
- noise from machinery and equipment during standard work hours.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light
