Start of construction works for Denmark Link Road from early March



Transport for NSW (Transport) is continuing work on the North West Growth Area Road Network Strategy. Early and pre-construction works for the Denmark Link Road upgrade project are now complete, while utility investigations are ongoing.

The main work is being delivered in five stages, with each stage taking between two to three months with some overlap between stages. The work has been staged to lessen the disruption to the community and traffic.

We are ready to commence our Stage 1 works which will include construction of a new link road between Carlton Street and Denmark Road and between West Parade and Bridge Street. As part of this work, we will:

- dig up existing topsoil and replace it with new materials
- begin constructing the new drainage systems
- build new boundary fences



What are we doing?

From Monday 6 March, we will be starting major work for the Denmark Link Road Project. This will include the use of graders, excavators, trucks and rollers to begin construction of a new road between Denmark Road and Carlton Street and between West Parade and Bridge Street.

Our work schedule

We will be working between Carlton Street and Denmark Road and between West Parade and Bridge Street from Monday 6 March. This work will be carried out during the day. We are working towards finishing this first stage of the road upgrade by June, weather permitting. Our work hours are 7am - 6pm Monday to Friday.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance to surrounding residents and businesses by using non-tonal beepers on reversing vehicles and turning off machinery when not in use.

Equipment used for these activities include heavy and light vehicles, rollers, excavators, graders, bobcats and hand and power tools.

Traffic changes

Most of the work will take place between Carlton Street and Denmark Road and between West Parade and Bridge Street. There will be minimal traffic changes during our work. In some instances, there may be traffic control in place where the new road will connect to existing streets and for the movement of heavy plant and machinery. Please follow the signs and traffic controllers' directions. Access to residential properties will always be maintained.
