Denmark Link Road

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the new Denmark Link Road at Riverstone as part of the North West Growth Area Road Network Strategy.

Background

Denmark Link Road will be a new link road between Garfield Road West, Riverstone and the Westminster Street Bridge, Schofields.

This connection will ease traffic congestion along Garfield Road West around the railway level crossing at Riverstone and would provide an alternate local

connection for light vehicles to cross the Richmond railway line, to avoid the Riverstone town centre.

Work commenced in February. We have begun constructing the new link road between Denmark Road and Carlton Street and also between Bridge Street and West Parade.

Denmark Link Road

Features

- building a two-lane local road connecting Garfield Road West and Bridge Street
- new right-turn bay along Garfield Road West for traffic waiting to enter Denmark Road at Riverstone
- widening the existing Denmark Road, Trevithick Street and West Parade
- extending Denmark Road
- building a new link road between Denmark Road and Carlton Street
- building a new intersection at Carlton Street
- extending West Parade to connect to Bridge Street, near the Westminster Street Bridge at Schofields.

Project benefits

Benefits of the project include:

- reducing the congestion and delays that are currently experienced at the Garfield Road railway level crossing at Riverstone
- providing a local road connection for light vehicles wishing to use the Westminster Street Bridge, reducing congestion on Garfield Road.

Staging of work

The project has been divided into five stages to reduce traffic impacts and to maintain access for residents at all times during project construction.

The new link roads are part of our Stage 1 works and have been under construction since February. We began our Stage 2 works near Carlton and Trevithick Street from 24 April.

Asbestos removal

During our Stage 1 works, we found some asbestos contaminated material which we had to remove. It is possible that more asbestos will be found as we progress. To make sure there is no risk to the community and our workers, we will continue to:

- follow an asbestos management plan that details safe work practices
- make sure the asbestos does not present an immediate safety risk
- follow all Environment Protection Authority and SafeWork NSW requirements for removal of asbestos material
- maintain strict safety precautions during the removal including workers wearing protective suits and masks and the work area being isolated with safety fences and asbestos warning signs
- send the material to a licensed asbestos disposal facility.

What have we achieved so far?

Works have begun between Denmark Road and Carlton Street and also Bridge Street and West Parade. In these sections, the topsoil has been removed and drainage systems, including new culverts, are under construction. We have also commenced replacing the material in these sections and bringing the road back up to its original height.

We have begun upgrading sections of Carlton Street, West Parade and Trevithick Street.

Our work May – July

Work scheduled over the next three months includes:

- continuing work between Carlton and Denmark Road and between Bridge Street and West Parade to construct new link roads
- upgrading Trevithick Street, Carlton Street and West Parade
- upgrading the other half of Carlton Street and West Parade.

Our work schedule

Most of the work will be carried out during standard working hours **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**. If we need to work at night and weekends, we will notify you in advance.

Traffic changes

Trevithick Street, part of Carlton Street and a southbound section of West Parade, will remain closed for up to 8 weeks **to mid June**. Access to residential properties and businesses will always be maintained. Timed traffic lights will be in place to ensure safe flow of traffic and construction vehicles. Please follow the signs and traffic controllers’ directions.
