


Doonside Station Upgrade

Accessibility upgrade now complete

The Doonside Station Upgrade, part of the Transport Access Program to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/ carers with prams, and customers with luggage, is now complete.

The upgraded facilities and improved accessibility features are now available to customers including:

- Four new lifts connecting the station entrances to the existing footbridge and station platforms
- Continuous canopy coverage on both platforms from the new lifts to the boarding assistance zones
- ✓ New stairs on platform 3 and 4
- Upgrading the existing ramp, footbridge and the stairs on Platform 1 and 2 with a new roof.

Finishing works

Customers may continue to see construction staff on site throughout November and December while finishing works take place in the coming weeks. These works will be carried out during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm, and Saturdays 8am to 1pm.

Aboriginal Artwork

We have installed the Aboriginal artwork at the Cross Street station entrance that represents the cultural connection to the land and the traditional hunting practices of the Wawarrawarri people of the Dharug Nation.

The depiction of the bird-catching process with strung-up nets and boomerangs adds a meaningful touch to the station's entrance.

Sustainability


- Reduced carbon emissions during construction through use of solar lighting towers
- Using lower carbon emission intensive cement
- Reduced water use in operations through more water efficient fixtures and fittings in toilets
- Reduced construction water use by 10,000L rainwater tank at the site office
- 97% of construction and demolition waste diverted from landfill
