Doonside Station Upgrade

Construction update | February 2023

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Doonside Station as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure, and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

What we've achieved

- 90% of the building work for the family accessible toilet completed
- 100% of the station building kitchenette completed
- 50% of concrete structure for lift located on Platform 1 / 2 completed
- Eastwood Lane drainage completed.

Day work continuing

In February, work at the station will continue **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and **from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays**. This work includes but is not limited to:

- civil, concrete, steel and glazing work to construct the new lifts and canopies
- excavating and trenching on Cross Street, and School Parade
- landscaping and upgrading the footpaths and roads around the station
- upgrading and cutover of station services.

Out-of-hours work

Some activities are required to be carried out outside of our standard work hours. These activities have been planned during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends.

We are planning to work from 5am on Saturday 18 until 10pm on Sunday 19 February.

Key activities during this weekend work period include:

- Preparing the foundation for the lift near Eastwood Lane
- Removing scaffold and building piles on Platform 1 and 2
- Removing existing canopy steel
- Upgrading the station's power supply
- Carrying out platform drainage works.

Over those two days, **the station footbridge will be closed** to allow for work to be carried out safely. A **free shuttle bus service** will be in place to allow for travel between Cross Street and Doonside Road.

We are also planning to work **three nights in late February** to carry out trenching work in front of the School Parade entrance. We will notify residents and businesses closer to the date.

Schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions.



We are proud to acknowledge the Dharug people as the traditional custodians of the land for this project.

How the work may affect you

- At times there will be periods of high noise: we will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, including turning equipment off when not in use and positioning equipment as far away from properties as possible.
- **Temporary parking removal:** at times, up to eight car spaces at the access gate (please see the map) on School Parade will be required to facilitate vehicle access.
- Temporary lane closure: From around late February, access to the station via Eastwood Lane (from Illoura Place) will be restricted at times to allow for paving and landscaping. Access will be maintained via Doonside Road.
- Increase in construction traffic: construction vehicles will access the rail corridor via the access gate on School Pde. At times temporary parking removal will be required to provide access.

Laydown areas: these secured areas on Coghlan Cres. and Rosenthal Street are required to store materials and support work occurring outside the rail corridor.
