Work will continue at the Emu Plains Commuter Car Park in the coming month.

What work are we doing?

Work in April will include:

- staged construction of the roundabout at Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street
- relocation of a water main on Old Bathurst Road requiring temporary road closures
- construction of new footpaths including landscaping and fencing
- general construction work within the new commuter car park site

When and where we'll be working

Throughout April, we will be working within the commuter car park site, along Old Bathurst Road, and at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street.

Standard work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.**

Night work in April and May

A section of Old Bathurst Road between Great Western Highway and Smith Street **will be closed for night work between 9pm and 5am on weeknights for:**

- up to four nights in the week **starting Monday 3 April until Thursday 6 April** for relocation of

a large water main on Old Bathurst Road

- up to three nights from **Wednesday 26 April** for road pavement work

The map on the next page shows the detour route during road closure periods.

Further night work may be required for up to two nights in the week **starting Tuesday 11 April** for water utility work, subject to weather and Sydney Water approval. No road closure will be in place during this time.

Night work will be required in May, with further details to be provided.

What will this mean for you?

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and may be varied without additional notification. You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- road and lane closures, reduced speed limits
- noise from construction machinery and equipment that may include lighting towers, excavators, bobcat, mobile crane, tip trucks, concrete mixer, asphalt machine, service and delivery vehicles, generators, compactors



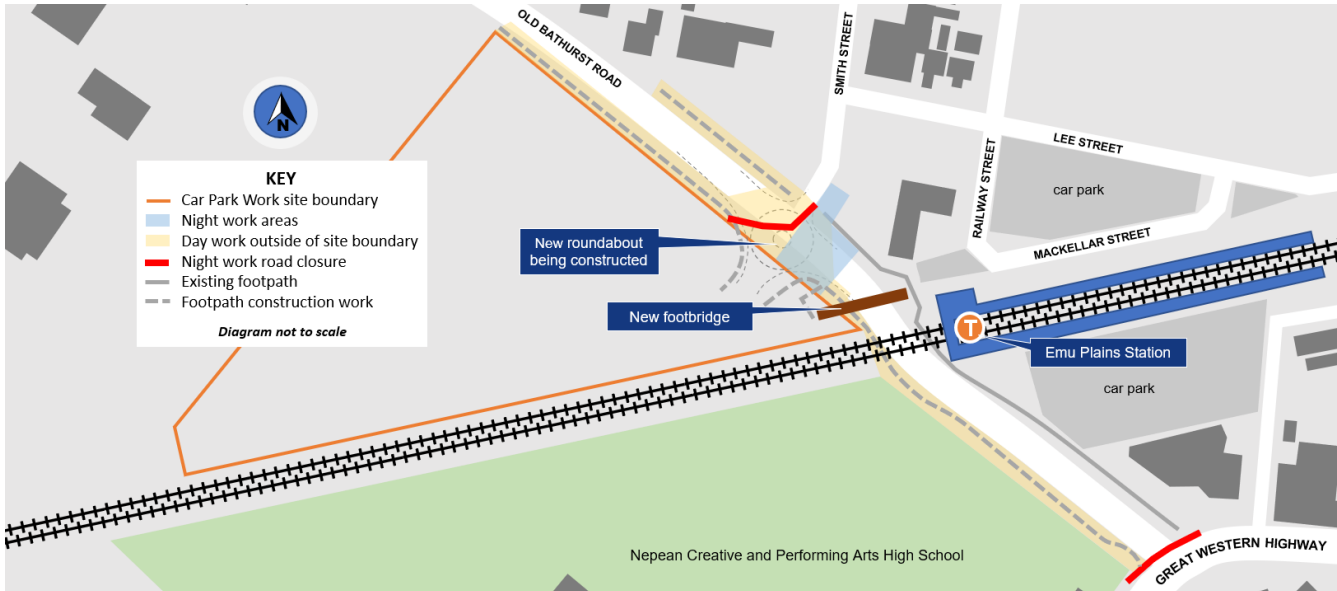
Managing our impacts

This includes:

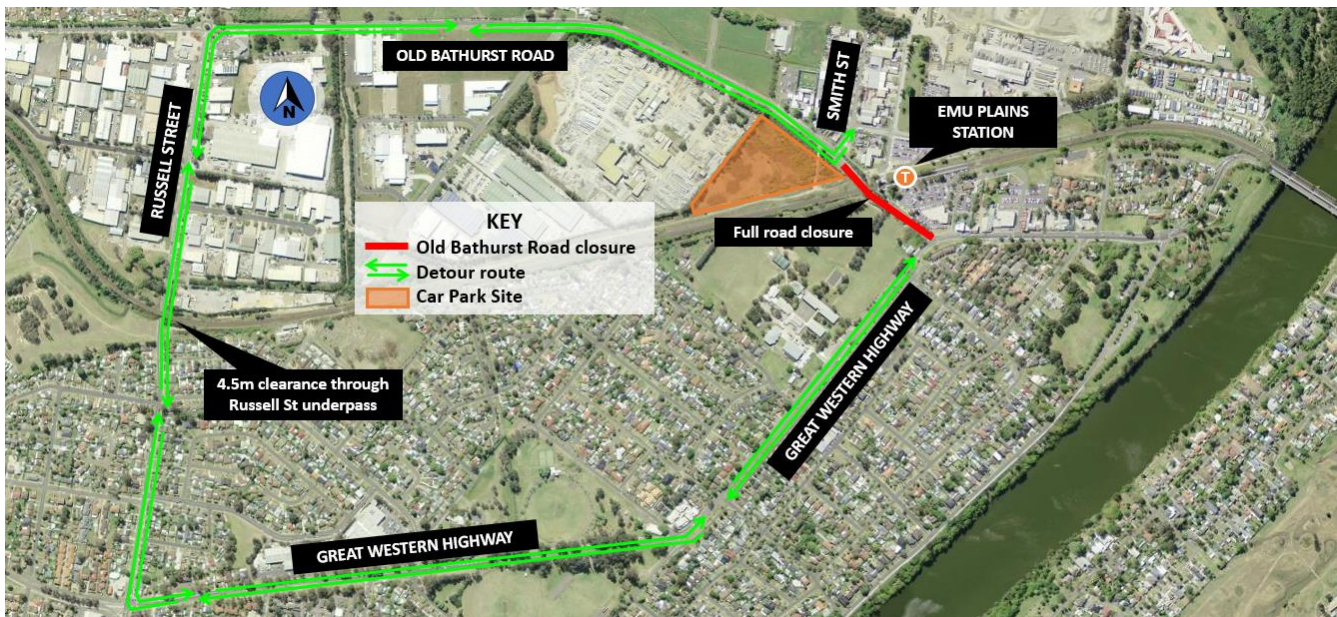
- fencing for safety and security
