Transport for NSW acknowledges the traditional custodians of the land and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is constructing a new commuter car park at Emu Plains Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments.

The car park, which will be accessed via a new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, will provide approximately 750 additional commuter parking spaces.

What work are we doing?

Work activities in June will include:

- concrete work for the new roundabout at Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, as well as line marking, signage and asphaltting
- landscaping along Old Bathurst Road
- general construction within the commuter car park site.

Night work in June

A section of Old Bathurst Road between Great Western Highway and Smith Street **will be closed for night work for up to five weeknights between 9pm and 5am throughout June** to undertake finishing work on the new roundabout and utility work.

Road users are advised to observe roadside signage for up-to-date information regarding nightwork.

The map on the next page shows the detour route via Russell Street during road closure periods.

When and where we'll be working

In June work will be undertaken within the commuter car park site, along Old Bathurst Road, and within Smith Street.

Standard work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.**

What will this mean for you?

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and may be varied without additional notification. You may notice:

- signage installed to control traffic for the roundabout at the Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street intersection
- traffic controllers and temporary signage providing the latest updates to road users
- road and lane closures, reduced speed limits
- noise from construction machinery and equipment that may include lighting towers, excavators, bobcat, mobile crane, tip trucks, concrete mixer, asphalt machine, service and delivery vehicles, generators, compactors.

Managing our impacts

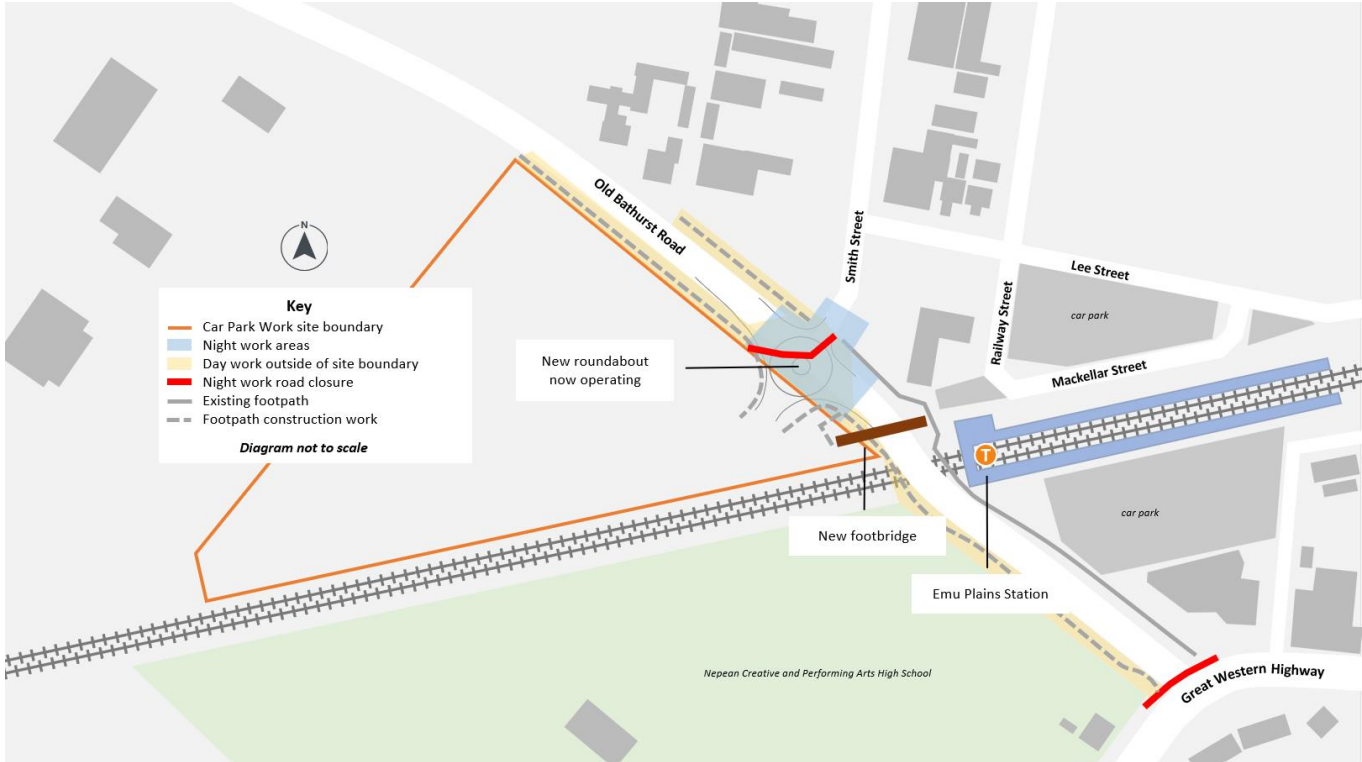
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

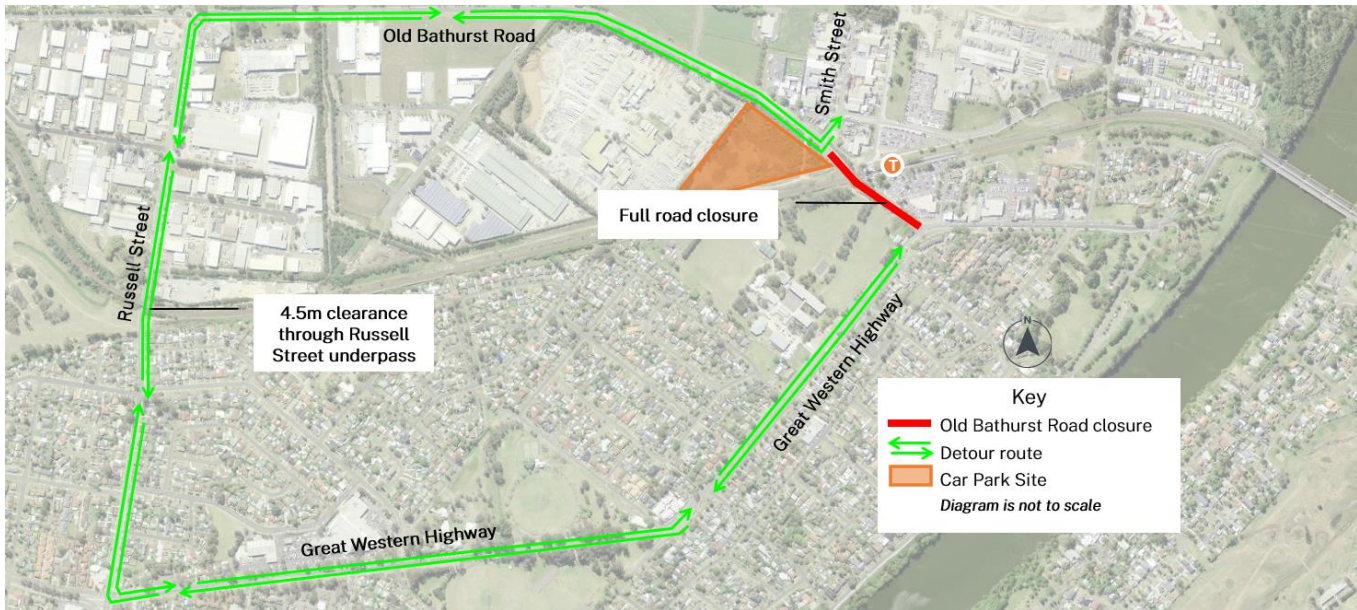
- fencing and barriers for safety and security
