



Erskineville Station Upgrade Community Update

Transport Access Program

May - July 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Erskineville Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What work will we be doing?

Day work at the station will continue **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm, and from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays.**

Activities include:

- Installing canopy steel and roofing
- Improvements to the footbridges and staircases
- Landscaping work
- Installing platform furniture and fencing.

Planned out of hours work

Some activities are required to be carried out outside of our standard work hours. These activities have been planned during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends as follows;

- from **4am Saturday 6 until 10pm Sunday 7 May**
- from **4am Saturday 13 until 10pm Sunday 14 May**
- from **4am Saturday 20 until 10pm Sunday 21 May**
- from **4am Saturday 24 until 10pm Sunday 25 June**
- from **4am Saturday 1 until 10pm Sunday 2 July**
- from **4am Saturday 29 until 10pm Sunday 30 July**

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Changes to scheduled works

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be a significant change to the construction program.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- The use of noise blankets where possible, replacing reversing beepers with clickers
- Traffic control and signage will be in place
- Directional lighting pointed away from residential properties wherever possible
