


# Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration Project

More Trains, More Services

June - July 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure between to simplify and modernise the rail network so that customers can expect more frequent train services in the future. We are also making improvements to electrical infrastructure to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new air-conditioned trains.

### Project milestone

In December 2020, we installed four new crossovers inside the rail corridor that allow trains to cross between railway lines. Since then we have been upgrading signalling, electrical, overhead wiring, track and drainage infrastructure to support the new crossovers.

We are pleased to share that the new crossovers were successfully commissioned last month, meaning they are now ready for operational use.

This represents a significant milestone for our project and we would like to thank you for your patience to date.

## What work are we doing?

In June and July 2023 we will continue to upgrade electrical, signalling and overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor.

You may also notice work and deliveries inside our site compounds at Railway Parade and Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard. The majority of work and deliveries will be scheduled during the day, however some will be required at night during scheduled trackwork periods.

## When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Some work and deliveries will take place outside of standard construction hours as detailed overleaf.



#### Out-of-hours work and deliveries

For safety reasons, some work and deliveries will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running from:

- 10pm Friday 9 June to 2am Tuesday 13 June
- 7am Saturday 17 June to Sunday 18 June
- 6am Saturday 1 July to 6pm Sunday 2 July
- 10pm Tuesday 4 July to 10pm Monday 10 July
- 10pm Friday 14 July to 2am Monday 17 July
- 10pm Friday 21 July to 2am Monday 24 July
- 10pm Friday 28 July to 2am Monday 31 July.

You may notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles
- deliveries of machinery and equipment
- noise from deliveries
- lighting from temporary lighting towers.
