### What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance at Fairfield from Saturday 25 March to Sunday 26 March.

To improve service reliability, we're working on:

- Rail grinding
- Track reconditioning, re-railing and resurfacing
- Litter and graffiti removal and vegetation maintenance.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

### How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 8pm Saturday 25 March until 10am Sunday 26 March.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place before and following this period, including the removal of equipment and materials.

#### Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor and in the adjacent Council Car Park where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
