

Changed traffic conditions for night work on the Great Western Highway at River Lett Hill on Sunday 19 March

Essential maintenance work is taking place at River Lett Hill, approximately 11 kilometres east of Lithgow

The work includes asphaltting to provide an improved road surface on a 100 metre section of the Great Western Highway. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working between **7pm** and **6am** on **Sunday 19 March** and expect to complete the work in **one night**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of motorists and out workers, work will be taking place at night. The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work. Outside of work hours speed limits of 80km/h will be in place.
