

## Traffic switch on the Great Western Highway at Raglan from May 16

The NSW Government is funding essential upgrade works on the Great Western Highway between Kelso and Raglan to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road.

From Tuesday 16 May traffic on the Great Western Highway between Napoleon Street and Bathurst Sheds will be moved onto the newly constructed road, completing a three kilometre traffic switch. We have included a map to show the change.

### Traffic changes

Traffic control and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place on Tuesday 16 May from 8am until 4pm which may affect travel times.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work. Outside of work hours a speed limit of 60km/h will be in place.

While work takes place to facilitate the switch, the road surface may be uneven, so please take extra care.

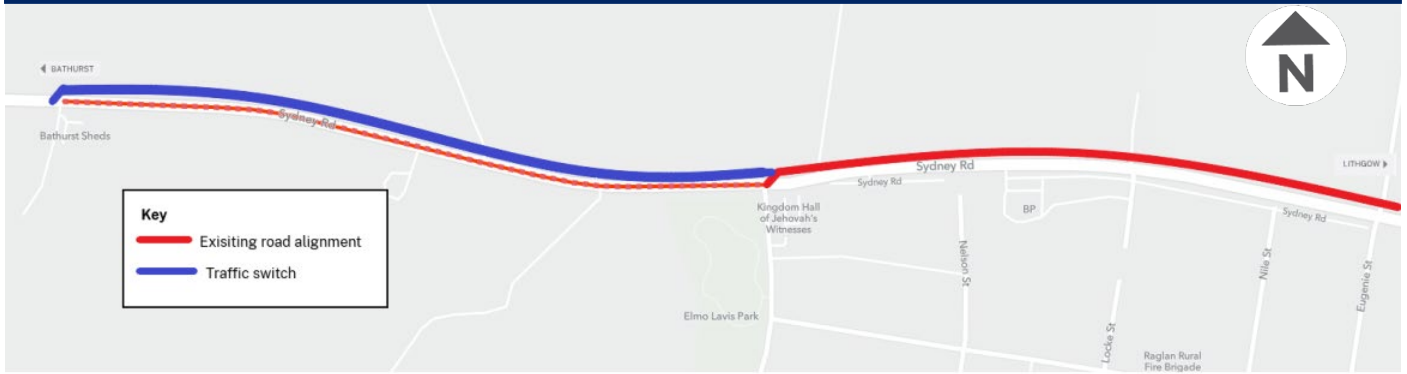
