

Road work on Gasworks Bridge, Parramatta from Monday 28 March to Thursday 14 April 2022

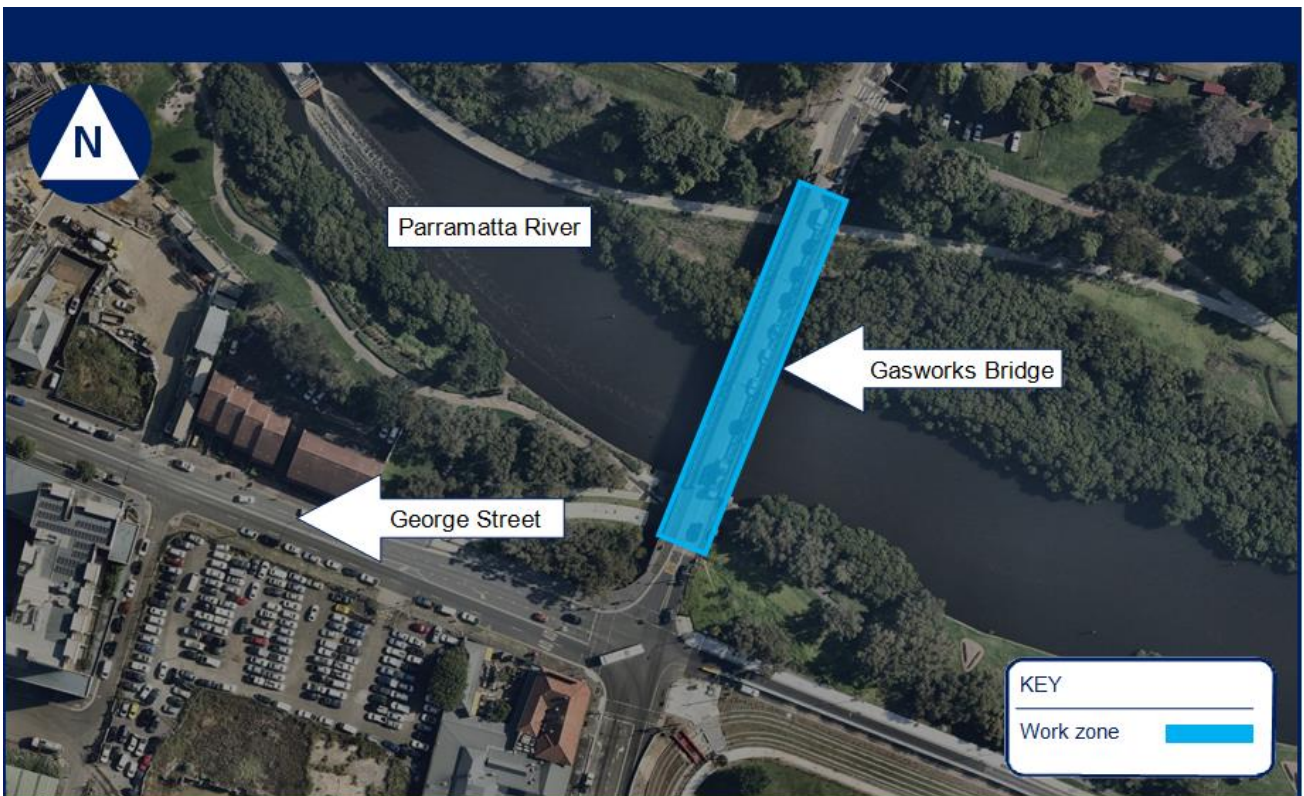

Transport for NSW will carry out investigation work and cleaning on Gasworks Bridge (Macarthur Street) over Parramatta River, Parramatta. Investigation work will inform future remediation of the bridge planned for later in the year.

The work will involve cleaning debris out of the bridge drainage, drilling into the road surface to determine the thickness of asphalt layers, and carrying out visual inspections of the bridge from the water (using a boat) and land.

Our maintenance work aims to:

- provide a smoother road surface
- prevent or minimise damage to roads from weather and wear and tear
- increase safety
- provide consistent driving conditions
- reduce maintenance costs.



Our work schedule

We will be on site for **two night shifts** and **12 day shifts** between **Monday 21 March** and **Thursday 14 April**, weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**.

How will the work affect you?

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to workers and motorists. It may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by midnight and using noise blankets.

To carry out the visual inspection of the bridge from the water, we will need to use a boat and an elevated work platform. To reduce impact to ferries and ferry users, we will carry out this work during a scheduled ferry shutdown between Parramatta and Rydalmere Wharfs, between Monday 21 March and Friday 8 April.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Access will be maintained for motorists in both directions. Pedestrian access across and under the bridge will also be maintained at all times.
