


Glenfield to Campbelltown Infrastructure Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

September 2023

The More Trains, More Services program is simplifying and modernising the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

What work are we doing?

In September 2023, activities will include:

- site survey and investigation work for future planning of construction, environment and safety controls
- identifying existing services and signalling routes
- installing underground and above ground cable routes within the rail corridor
- modifications and adjustments to Glenfield, Glenfield South and Ingleburn substations
- installing overhead wiring structures and footings
- overhead wiring adjustment work.

When and where we'll be working

In September 2023, work will be carried out in and adjacent to the rail corridor between Glenfield and Campbelltown.

Standard construction hours are from 7am until 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am until 1pm on Saturdays.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- mid-week deliveries
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- minor vegetation removal at Ingleburn Station
- installation of temporary boundary fencing, site sheds and power generators at Macquarie Fields and Ingleburn Station.
- temporary reservation of car spaces at Ingleburn Station to facilitate our work, including relocation of accessible spaces and removal of two spaces in the taxi rank.

- moderate noise from machinery and equipment.

Out of hours work

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours between:

- 6pm Friday 15 September and 7am Monday 18 September 2023
- 6pm Friday 22 September and 7am Monday 25 September 2023.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts to the surrounding community
- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- directing lighting away from residents
- conducting on site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

Temporary parking impacts

The spaces indicated in the image above will be temporarily reserved for a period of 10 days in September 2023.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists and passengers during this period.

Why we work outside of standard construction hours

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.
