# Start of early work on the New England Highway Goonoo Goonoo Road duplication from Monday 30 January

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing \$40 million for the duplication of Goonoo Goonoo Road (New England Highway) between Jack Smyth Drive and Calala Lane, Tamworth.

Transport for NSW is planning to start major work on the upgrade in **December 2024**, weather permitting. The upgrade will involve installing a set of traffic signals at the intersection of Goonoo Goonoo Road and Calala Lane, installing a roundabout at the intersection of Goonoo Goonoo Road and Craigends Lanes and intersection improvements for The Ringers Road and Greg Norman Drive.

The project also involves installing a central median to separate oncoming traffic and a new pedestrian and cycle path along the western side of the highway.

In preparation for this work, we will be carrying out early work activities including building around 48 metres of shared path on the western side of Goonoo Goonoo Road, installing new line marking for the shared path, relocating services and minor vegetation clearing. We have included a map to show you the location of these early work activities.

Tamworth Regional Council will be delivering this work on behalf of Transport for NSW and will be working from **Monday 30 January** between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Saturday**. This work is expected to be completed in **10 shifts**, weather permitting.

We will provide you with an update about the start of major work on the project once the work schedule has been finalised.

### How will this work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Resident's driveways will remain accessible.

#### **Traffic changes**

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Single lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during work hours, which may affect travel times.
